## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 7

- A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING NAKOBE DEAN,
  OUTSIDE LINEBACKER FOR THE NATIONAL CHAMPION UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA
  "BULLDOGS" FOOTBALL TEAM FROM HORN LAKE HIGH SCHOOL, FOR HIS
  OUTSTANDING COLLEGE FOOTBALL CAREER.
- 5 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi was well represented on the
- 6 National Champion University of Georgia "Bulldogs" Football Team.
- 7 Nakobe Dean is the six-foot, 215-pound Outside Linebacker of the
- 8 National Champions from Horn Lake High School in Horn Lake,
- 9 Mississippi; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Dean, who won the 2021 Butkus Award, given to the
- 11 nation's best linebacker, completed his junior year with 168 total
- 12 tackles and 7.5 sacks. He also earned First-Team All-SEC Honors
- 13 in 2021. It remains to be seen if Dean will return to Georgia for
- 14 his senior year, or declare for the 2022 NFL Draft; and

- WHEREAS, Georgia defeated Alabama 33-18 in the College
- 16 Football National Championship Game, Georgia's first National
- 17 Title in football since the 1980 season. It's Georgia's first win
- 18 against Alabama since 2007, making Dean part of a historic college
- 19 football event; and

- 20 WHEREAS, on October 22, 2021, Dean returned to his alma
- 21 mater, Horn Lake, Mississippi, to present a check for \$10,000.00
- 22 to Hope Community Center, Inc., as part of the 2021 Allstate Good
- 23 Works Team. He is one of 22 players, and one of four players from
- 24 the Southeast Conference (SEC), to be nominated. The American
- 25 Football Coaches Association recognizes a select group of players
- 26 each year based on their commitment to serving their communities.
- 27 Dean said it means a lot to him to be able to give back to Horn
- 28 Lake. The Hope Community Center, Inc., of North Mississippi
- 29 provides a variety of safe, fun and exciting after-school
- 30 activities and events for youth of all ages; and
- 31 WHEREAS, Dean has also given his time to "Dawgs for Pups,"
- 32 which has raised \$200,000.00 to help local youth in the
- 33 Athens/Clarke County area; visited Camp Sunshine, which provides
- 34 recreational, educational and support programs for children with
- 35 cancer; led an effort that raised \$100,000.00 for Wi-Fi hotspots;
- 36 served on a team that collected 27,000 pounds of food for the
- 37 Northeast Georgia Food Bank; participated in the Bulldogs Battling
- 38 Breast Cancer Golf Tournament; collected 437 new and gently used
- 39 coats for the Boys & Girls Club of Athens; and read to students as
- 40 part of Read Across America; and
- 41 WHEREAS, Nakobe Dean has a 3.53 GPA in Mechanical Engineering
- 42 in the classroom. On the field, prior to the National
- 43 Championship Game, he had 30 tackles, 3.5 sacks and one
- 44 interception. He was Georgia's leading tackler in 2020 with 71

- 45 stops, which was 19 more than the closest Bulldog defender, with
- 46 1.5 tackles for a loss, 1.5 sacks and four quarterback hurries.
- 47 As a freshman in 2019, Dean had 25 tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss,
- 48 two pass breakups and a forced fumble; and
- WHEREAS, at Horn Lake, Dean was part of the team that won the
- 50 Mississippi High School Activities Association (MHSAA) 6A State
- 51 Football Championship and was the recipient of the Dick Butkus
- 52 Award as the nation's top linebacker in 2018. He was also named
- 53 Mississippi Mr. 6A Football and played in the Under Armour
- 54 All-American Football Game; and
- 55 WHEREAS, analysts say Dean has been an impactful player and
- 56 was the unquestioned leader of the Bulldogs, whose defense is
- 57 ranked number one, allowing only 297.1 total yards per game, and
- 58 only 5.5 points per game; and
- 59 WHEREAS, Horn Lake Football Head Coach Mitchell Harville, who
- 60 first coached Dean in the seventh and eighth grade, said he is
- 61 pleased to see Dean excelling at such a high level at Georgia.
- "It's been exciting watching him his entire time at Georgia,"
- 63 Harville said. "From the time he got there as a freshman, he has
- 64 been able to do so much." Harville explained it was clear early
- on that Dean was a special player; and
- 66 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we recognize a very
- 67 special Mississippi athlete who has brought honor to his home
- 68 town, his high school and to the State of Mississippi:

- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 70 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate Nakobe
- 71 Dean, Outside Linebacker for the National Champions Georgia
- 72 "Bulldogs" Football Team from Horn Lake High School, for his
- 73 outstanding college football career, and extend our best wishes to
- 74 Nakobe Dean and his family as he transitions from the highest
- 75 level of college football into the NFL.
- 76 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 77 Nakobe Dean, forwarded to Horn Lake High School Football Coach
- 78 Mitchell Harville for the team, and made available to the Capitol
- 79 Press Corps.
