- 5 WHEREAS, on March 17th, during the annual celebration of the
- 6 Feast of Saint Patrick, the Patron Saint of Ireland, Irish
- 7 Americans join with men, women and children of all ethnic origins
- 8 who, for one day, are considered honorary Irish and may celebrate
- 9 Saint Patrick and love of Ireland; and
- 10 WHEREAS, on Saint Patrick's Day, all who wear green live in
- 11 the spirit of Saint Patrick, Brigid and Colmcille whose 1500th
- 12 anniversary as patron saints occurred during the last year; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Irish immigrants helped form the cultural foundation
- 14 of the United States, and those of Irish lineage today proudly
- 15 sing their support for Ireland; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Mississippi has always had a strong history of
- 17 American Irish Relations. The Irish came to the Mississippi Delta
- 18 in the 1830s and were often considered expendable workers. Irish
- 19 day laborers were expected to work at the most dangerous and

- 20 unpleasant jobs, such as heavy construction in malaria-infested
- 21 areas. Natchez, Holly Springs and many areas of the Mississippi
- 22 Delta were settled by Irish immigrants; and
- 23 WHEREAS, the songs of Ireland are the tragic songs of love
- 24 and the joyous songs of battle: the nostalgic reveries of the
- 25 sorrows and the glories that are the Emerald Isle; and the
- 26 lamentations of life's myriad travails and the odes to joy and the
- 27 life eternal; and
- 28 WHEREAS, we celebrate the establishment of the American Irish
- 29 State Legislators Caucus with its aim of fostering and
- 30 strengthening the long-standing relationship that exists between
- 31 the United States of America and Ireland to the mutual benefit of
- 32 both countries with leadership in all 50 states:
- 33 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 34 MISSISSIPPI, That we commemorate the celebration of the Feast of
