- 4 WHEREAS, Picayune High School Football Coach Cody Stogner
- 5 knew his "Maroon Tide" Football Team were underdogs against West
- 6 Point in the MHSAA Class 5A State Football Championship. However,
- 7 that did not matter on December 4, 2021, in Hattiesburg, when
- 8 Picayune (14-1) upset West Point High School 40-21, after falling
- 9 behind 21-20, holding the Green Wave to seven points in the second
- 10 half to win the championship. It was Coach Stogner's first
- 11 championship as Head Coach; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Junior running back Dante Dowdell led the way with
- 13 25 carries, 149 yards and two touchdowns as the Maroon Tide
- 14 avenged their 2019 State Championship Game loss to West Point; and
- 15 WHEREAS, Picayune took control in the second half. The
- 16 Maroon Tide trailed 21-20 with 8:47 left in the third quarter
- 17 before Darrell Smith broke free for a 59-yard touchdown run. The
- 18 freshman running back finished with 10 carries for 88 yards.

- 19 Dowdell and Smith were jointed by Chris Davis as Picayune's
- 20 three-headed rushing attack. Davis finished with eight carries
- 21 for 139 yards and two touchdowns. Dowdell capped off a 12-play,
- 22 80-yard drive with a 2-yard touchdown run with 11:10 remaining.
- 23 The score gave Picayune a 34-21 lead. Sophomore defensive end
- 24 Jamonta Waller sealed the victory with a 35-yard fumble recovery
- 25 for a touchdown on the following drive; and
- 26 WHEREAS, the second-half defensive performance was a
- 27 culmination of what Stogner believed for most of the season. The
- 28 Maroon Tide allowed 16 points per game during their 11-game
- 29 winning streak. "I believe we got the best defense in the state,"
- 30 Stogner stated; and
- 31 WHEREAS, the 2021 Picayune MHSAA Class 5A Football
