## SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 55

1	A RESOLUTION COMMENDING AND CONGRATULATING THE ALCORN STATE
2	UNIVERSITY "BRAVES" MEN'S BASKETBALL TEAM AND HEAD COACH LANDON
3	BUSSIE FOR WINNING THE 2022 SOUTHWESTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE
4	(SWAC) REGULAR SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP.
5	WHEREAS, the Alcorn State University "Braves" Men's
6	Dagkothall Moam glinghod the 2021 2022 Southwestern Athletic

- Basketball Team clinched the 2021-2022 Southwestern Athletic
- 7 Conference (SWAC) Regular Season title, for the first time in 20
- years, after defeating rival, the University of Arkansas Pine 8
- Bluff (UAPB), 100-77 on March 6, 2022, and breaking the 100-point 9
- 10 scoring threshold for the first time since the 2019-2020 season;
- 11 and
- 12 WHEREAS, with five Braves putting up double figures in the
- contest, Keondre Montgomery, a Jackson native, came off the bench 13
- 14 to put up 21 points to lead the Braves in the effort, going for
- 7-for-10 from the field, including 5-of-6 in three-point range, as 15
- 16 well as adding two points at the free-throw line and bringing down
- 17 five boards; and
- WHEREAS, with his first double-double of the season, Justin 18
- 19 Thomas contributed to the Braves' expansive lead with 11 points

- 20 and 10 assists, while fellow teammates, Lenell Henry netted 17
- 21 points and led the team in rebounding with nine boards,
- 22 complemented by Byron Joshua's 15 points and Darrious Agnew's 14
- 23 points to round out the Braves' double-digit scoring; and
- 24 WHEREAS, making 41 of 63 from the floor, including nine of 17
- 25 from beyond the arch, the Braves were shooting 80.6% from the
- 26 field, with a 75% accuracy from three-point range; and
- 27 WHEREAS, a fast-paced run from the first quarter tip-off, saw
- 28 the Braves dominate UAPB by sinking 90% of their shot attempts,
- 29 and the combined successes of Montgomery and Henry from behind the
- 30 arc bolstered the Braves' scoring run, the largest of the contest
- 31 as Alcorn would lead the Golden Lions by 32 points, with just 2:49
- 32 seconds left before the break to enter halftime with a 63-36
- 33 advantage; and
- WHEREAS, mounting a formidable defense and full-court press
- 35 on the offense at the onset of the second half, UAPB was able to
- 36 slowly chip away at the Braves' lead to within 18 points, 95-77.
- 37 However, Alcorn's sheer grit and determination to emerge
- 38 victorious was enough to hold the Golden Lions at bay, not
- 39 allowing them to score another point, while adding five points to
- 40 their final tally through the contribution of Thomas, who hit a
- 41 two-point jumper, followed by Montgomery's skillful landing of a
- 42 three-pointer during the final minute; and
- WHEREAS, we join the students, faculty and sponsors in
- 44 recognizing this special group of university student-athletes who

- 45 reached one of the pinnacles of collegiate basketball excellence
- 46 and have brought honor to their university, their community and to
- 47 the State of Mississippi:
- 48 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 49 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby commend and congratulate the Alcorn
- 50 State University "Braves" Men's Basketball Team and Head Coach
- 51 Landon Bussie for winning the 2022 SWAC Regular Season
- 52 Championship, and extend to the athletes and coaches our best
- 53 wishes for continued success.

- 55 Head Coach Landon Bussie, Interim Athletic Director Cyrus Russ,
- 56 and President Felecia M. Nave on behalf of the team, to the Board
