House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2600

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) There is created a study committee for the
- 7 purpose of studying the challenges of monitoring the formerly
- 8 incarcerated individuals in the pursuit of the reduction of
- 9 recidivism through targeted support, supervision and skills
- 10 attainment, and for recommending solutions. The committee shall
- 11 be comprised of the following nine (9) members:
- 12 (a) Three (3) members of the Senate, to be appointed by
- 13 the Lieutenant Governor;
- 14 (b) Three (3) members of the House, to be appointed by
- 15 the Speaker of the House of Representatives;
- 16 (c) The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections,
- 17 or a designee, as an ex officio nonvoting member;
- 18 (d) The Chairman of the Mississippi Parole Board, or a
- 19 designee, as an ex officio nonvoting member; and
- 20 (e) The Executive Director of Accelerate Mississippi,
- 21 or a designee, as an ex officio nonvoting member.

- 22 (2) Appointments to the study committee shall be made within
- 23 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act. At the first
- 24 meeting, the committee shall elect from among its membership a
- 25 chairman, a vice chairman and any other officers determined to be
- 26 necessary, and shall adopt rules for transacting business and
- 27 keeping records.
- 28 (3) A majority of the members of the study committee shall
- 29 constitute a quorum. In the adoption of rules, resolutions and
- 30 reports, and in the election of a chairman, vice chairman and any
- 31 other officers determined to be necessary, an affirmative vote of
- 32 a majority of the members present shall be required.
- 33 (4) The Commissioner of the Department of Corrections shall
- 34 provide the staff and other support necessary for the study
- 35 committee to perform its duties.
- 36 (5) To effectuate the purposes of this act, any department,
- 37 division, board, bureau, committee, institution or agency of the
- 38 state, or any political subdivision thereof, shall, at the request
- 39 of the chairman of the study committee, provide the facilities,
- 40 assistance, information and data needed to enable the study
- 41 committee to carry out its duties.
- 42 (6) The study committee shall be dissolved on or before
- 43 January 1, 2023.
- 44 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 45 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

AN ACT TO CREATE A STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE CHALLENGES OF MONITORING FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS TO REDUCE RECIDIVISM THROUGH TARGETED SUPPORT, SUPERVISION AND SKILLS ATTAINMENT, AND TO RECOMMEND SOLUTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
