

## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 2913

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

### AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8           **SECTION 1.** Section 19-17-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is  
9 amended as follows:

10           19-17-17. The clerk of the board of supervisors, as county  
11 auditor, is authorized and required to examine the accounts,  
12 dockets and records of clerks, sheriffs and other officers  
13 of \* \* \* the clerk's county, to ascertain if any money payable  
14 into the county treasury is properly chargeable to them, and \* \* \*  
15 the clerk shall charge them with such money. \* \* \*

16           **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from  
17 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1           AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-17-17, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,  
2 TO DELETE THE DUTY OF THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO  
3 REPORT TO THE GRAND JURY THE RESULTS OF THE AUDIT REQUIRED BY THIS  
4 SECTION; TO DELETE THE CRIMINAL PENALTY AGAINST THE CLERK OF THE  
5 BOARD OF SUPERVISORS FOR FAILING TO REPORT TO THE GRAND JURY; AND  
6 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
