         SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
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    Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall
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    allocate funds to the off-campus centers based on a minimum rate
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- 48 of sixty-five percent (65%) of the on-campus cost of a full-time
- 49 equivalent student. The on-campus distribution is to be
- 50 determined without regard to the costs incurred by any one or more
- of them in the operation of off-campus degree-completing centers'
- 52 classes. Off-campus centers which are operated jointly by two (2)
- 53 or more institutions, the amount allocated to such centers shall
- 54 be prorated among the institutions jointly operating such centers
- 55 based on the full-time equivalent enrollment of such centers.
- The board of trustees shall ensure that the off-campus

- 136 **SECTION 14.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 137 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning
- 138 continue to review, and eliminate when possible, duplicating
- 139 programs and degrees in the existing institutions of higher
- 140 learning in this state.
- 141 **SECTION 15.** No state appropriations or student tuition and
- 142 fee receipts, except those specifically charged for the provision
- 143 of the services, shall be used to support auxiliary enterprises,
- 144 with the exception of intercollegiate athletics at a level
- 145 designated by the board of trustees. It is the intent of the
- 146 Legislature that auxiliary enterprises shall be self-supporting
- 147 and that deficits not be taken from funds intended for instruction
- 148 and academic programs.
- 149 **SECTION 16.** The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
- 150 Higher Learning shall report yearly to the Legislature the

In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the intended mission of this agency. - 215 **SECTION 24.** It is the intent of the Legislature that at the 216 end of Fiscal Year 2023 any unexpended balances in Ayers programs 217 funds established pursuant to this act shall not lapse into the 218 State General Fund, but shall carry over and be available for
- 219 expenditure in the succeeding fiscal year, and subject to
- 220 Legislative appropriation.
- SECTION 25. None of the State General Funds appropriated by this act shall be expended for the purpose of travel outside the United States.

268 SECTION 32. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 269 of Section 1 of this act, an amount not more than One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to 270 271 implement university system efficiencies, including, but not 272 limited to, academic, space, energy and any other system projects 273 or expenditures that would lead to improved efficiency. 274 funds may also be used to draw down other funds or as matching 275 funds.

276 SECTION 33. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 277 of Section 1 of this act, Eighty-seven Thousand Three Hundred 278 Dollars (\$87,300.00) shall be used to defray the expenses of the 279 Children's Center for Communication and Development at the

280 University of Southern Mississippi.

- 296 **SECTION 37.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this
- 297 act, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) is provided for
- 298 the Delta State University Delta Music Institute.
- 299 **SECTION 38.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 300 Mississippi Valley State University is authorized to provide water
- 301 or sewer service to any existing, privately-owned structures that
- 302 presently take water or sewer service from Mississippi Valley
- 303 State University. Furthermore, Mississippi Valley State
- 304 University is authorized to charge a flat or metered rate for the
- 305 service provided. Mississippi Valley State University shall not

306 provide any water or sewer service to any new, privately-owned 307 structures.

Twenty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$729,890.00)

shall be provided to the Charter School Authorizer Board. Of this amount, Two Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety

Dollars (\$229,890.00) shall be provided in General Funds and Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be provided in Special Funds from the Charter School Authorizer Board Fund - Fund No. 3001700000.

SECTION 39. Of the funds herein appropriated, Seven Hundred

This appropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of funds for construction and/or repair and renovation projects for the Institutions of Higher Learning as allocated herein:

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance of June 30, 2022.

335 **SECTION 41.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 337 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 338 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 339 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 340 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 341 actions contrary to this provision.

SECTION 42. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
