House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3031

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
5	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
6	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Dental
7	Examiners, for the support of said board for the fiscal year
8	beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023

10	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
11	this act, the following positions are authorized:

15	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
16	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
17	Services for Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2023 funds
18	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
19	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 budget by the Mississippi
20	Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's

21 personal services appropriation, which shall be published by the 22 State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board 23 shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll costs 24 based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the 25 agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for 26 Fiscal Year 2023 do not exceed the data provided by the 27 Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 28 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions 29 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception 30 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.

31 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 32 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 33 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 34 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 35 The 36 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 37 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 38 39 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating

S. B. 3031 PAGE 2 46 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 47 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.

54 SECTION 3. Of the funds provided under the provisions of 55 this act, an amount not to exceed Twenty-seven Thousand Dollars 56 (\$27,000.00) shall be allocated to the Mississippi Board of 57 Pharmacy to defray the expenses of the Mississippi Prescription 58 Monitoring Program.

59 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 60 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 61 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 62 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 63 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 64 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 65 actions contrary to this provision.

66 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that 67 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 68 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 69 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 70 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 71 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to S. B. 3031 PAGE 3 72 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 73 made without competitive bids.

74 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 75 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 76 77 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 78 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 79 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 80 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 81 and after July 1, 2022.
