## House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3035

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Examiners
9	for Licensed Professional Counselors, for the purpose of defraying
10	the expenses of the board for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023\$ 273,109.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
13	Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 2
16	Time-Limited: 0
17	No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
18	used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
19	being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
20	act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
21	None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
22	violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating

23 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 24 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

25 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Mississippi State Board of Examiners for Licensed Professional 26 27 Counselors shall maintain complete accounting and personnel 28 records related to the expenditure of all funds appropriated under 29 this act and that such records shall be in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 2022. It is further 30 31 the intention of the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 32 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 33 34 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2023 35 budget request process.

36 It is the intention of the Legislature that SECTION 4. whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 37 38 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 39 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 40 41 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 42 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 43 made without competitive bids.

44 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 45 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 46 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 47 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 48 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 5. B. 3035 PAGE 2 49 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 50 actions contrary to this provision.

51 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 52 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 53 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 54 55 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 56 57 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 2022.
