House Amendments to Senate Bill No. 3036

TO THE SECRETARY OF THE SENATE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE HOUSE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 5 **SECTION 1.** That the following sum, or so much thereof as may
- 6 be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State
- 7 Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of
- 8 Veterinary Examiners for the purpose of defraying the expenses
- 9 incurred by said board for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022,
- 10 and ending June 30, 2023.....\$ 192,617.00.
- 11 **SECTION 2.** Any transfers or escalations shall be made in
- 12 accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established
- 13 by law.
- 14 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 15 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 16 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 17 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- 18 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 19 Veterinary Examiners Board shall maintain complete accounting and
- 20 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 21 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the

- 22 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 23 2022. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 24 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be submitted to
- 25 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 26 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 27 during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.
- 28 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 29 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 30 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 31 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 32 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 33 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 34 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 35 made without competitive bids.
- 36 **SECTION 5.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 37 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 38 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 39 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 40 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 41 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 42 **SECTION 6.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 2022.
