- 116 After the governing authorities of the City of Meridian (3) 117 have adopted a resolution specifying the amount of the minimum monthly benefits authorized under subsection (1) of this section, 118 and the advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-9, 119 120 Mississippi Code of 1972, has adopted a resolution supporting the 121 payment of the specified amount of the minimum monthly benefits, 122 and after the Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' 123 Retirement System has received these resolutions and the most 124 recent actuarial study of the disability and relief fund and the 125 certified statement from the actuarial firm, pursuant to subsection (2) of this section, that the fund will remain 126 127 actuarially sound if the minimum monthly benefits are paid, then 128 the board of trustees shall pay those benefits to the persons 129 authorized and entitled to receive the payments.

- (4) Persons eligible to receive the minimum monthly benefits
 authorized under this section shall receive such payments monthly
 effective January 1, 1994. In the event of death of a person or a
 beneficiary thereof receiving monthly benefits, any remaining

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 943, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1993, AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 983, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1999, TO AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI, TO INCREASE, BY 2% EVERY JULY 1, BEGINNING JULY 1, 2022, THE MONTHLY BENEFITS OF PERSONS WHO, ON JUNE 30, 2022, ARE RECEIVING BENEFITS FROM THE MERIDIAN POLICE AND FIRE DISABILITY AND RELIEF FUND OR THE MERIDIAN GENERAL MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE RETIREMENT FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
