(c) "Project" or "projects" means construction,

28 (2)There is created in the State Treasury a special (a) fund, to be designated as the "Capital City Water/Sewer Projects 29 30 Fund, " which shall consist of funds appropriated or otherwise made 31 available by the Legislature in any manner and funds from any 32 other source designated for deposit into such fund. The fund 33 shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the 34 35 Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a state. 36 fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any
