17 The following sum of money, or so much thereof as SECTION 2. 18 may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of the proceeds from 19 any federal, student fees or other special source funds not 20 otherwise appropriated, to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning for the purpose of support of 21 22 education and general operations of Alcorn State University, Delta 23 State University, Jackson State University, Mississippi State 24 University, Mississippi University for Women, Mississippi Valley 25 State University, University of Mississippi, and University of 26 Southern Mississippi, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, 27 and ending June 30, 2023.....\$ 947,724,271.00.

SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 46 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall 47 allocate funds to the off-campus centers based on a minimum rate 48 of sixty-five percent (65%) of the on-campus cost of a full-time equivalent student. The on-campus distribution is to be 49 50 determined without regard to the costs incurred by any one or more 51 of them in the operation of off-campus degree-completing centers' 52 classes. Off-campus centers which are operated jointly by two (2) 53 or more institutions, the amount allocated to such centers shall be prorated among the institutions jointly operating such centers 54 55 based on the full-time equivalent enrollment of such centers.

56 The board of trustees shall ensure that the off-campus 57 centers are not charged with any indirect or overhead cost 58 prorated from any on-campus activity. It is the intention of the 59 Legislature that the on-campus operations charge the off-campus 60 centers with only actual direct charges.

61 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 62 act, the amount of One Hundred Forty-five Thousand Dollars 63 (\$145,000.00) shall be used for the promotion and expenses of the 64 Mississippi Governor's School for the Gifted and Talented.

65 Provided, however, that the Board of Trustees of State 66 Institutions of Higher Learning shall develop the governing policy 67 for faculty, course content and facilities selection on a competitive basis from all Mississippi senior colleges and 68 69 universities. The Mississippi Governor's School for the Gifted 70 and Talented shall accept not less than one (1) high school 71 student nominee from each accredited high school in Mississippi. 72 The nominees, selected under criteria developed and adopted by the 73 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, shall 74 be provided a two-week tuition-free program.

It is the intention of the Legislature that the 118 SECTION 11. 119 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning shall 120 first use special funds to the greatest extent possible to defray 121 the costs of providing remediation at the state-supported 122 institutions of higher learning.

123 SECTION 12. None of the funds appropriated by this act shall 124 be expended for any purpose that is not actually required or 125 necessary for performing any of the powers or duties of the Board 126 of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, or any of 127 the powers or duties of any institution under the jurisdiction of 128 the board of trustees, that are authorized by the Mississippi 129 Constitution of 1890, state or federal law, or rules or 130 regulations that implement state or federal law.

131 SECTION 13. It is the intention of the Legislature that the budget requests of the institutions for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be 132 133 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format 134 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 135 provided during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.

136 SECTION 14. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 137 Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning 138 continue to review, and eliminate when possible, duplicating

139 programs and degrees in the existing institutions of higher 140 learning in this state.

141 SECTION 15. No state appropriations or student tuition and fee receipts, except those specifically charged for the provision 142 143 of the services, shall be used to support auxiliary enterprises, 144 with the exception of intercollegiate athletics at a level designated by the board of trustees. It is the intent of the 145 146 Legislature that auxiliary enterprises shall be self-supporting 147 and that deficits not be taken from funds intended for instruction 148 and academic programs.

149 **SECTION 16.** The Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 150 Higher Learning shall report yearly to the Legislature the 151 institution compliance with Section 97-11-51, Mississippi Code of 152 1972, which prohibits deficit spending.

153 **SECTION 17.** Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 154 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 155 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 156 Mississippi and Section 25-4-105, Mississippi Code of 1972.

157 SECTION 18. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 158 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 159 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 160 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 161 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 162 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 163 performance measures provided below:

198 SECTION 21. It is the intention of the Legislature that 199 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 200 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 201 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 202 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 203 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 204 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 205 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 22. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following amount, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be allocated to Jackson State University E-Learning Center....\$ 485,000.00.

SECTION 24. It is the intent of the Legislature that at the end of Fiscal Year 2023 any unexpended balances in Ayers programs funds established pursuant to this act shall not lapse into the State General Fund, but shall carry over and be available for expenditure in the succeeding fiscal year, and subject to Legislative appropriation.

221 SECTION 25. None of the State General Funds appropriated by 222 this act shall be expended for the purpose of travel outside the 223 United States.

SECTION 26. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, shall be allocated to Delta State University Department of Commercial Aviation...... 800,000.00.

SECTION 27. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 and Section 2 of this act, One Hundred Ninety-one Thousand Six Hundred Ten Dollars (\$191,610.00) is provided for geospatial site licenses.

SECTION 28. It is the intention of the Legislature that none of the funds provided herein shall be used to pay certain utilities for state-furnished housing for any employees. Such utilities shall include electricity, natural gas, butane, propane, cable and phone services. Where actual cost cannot be determined, the agency shall be required to provide meters to be in compliance

with legislative intent. Such state-furnished housing shall include single-family and multifamily residences but shall not include any dormitory residences. Allowances for such utilities shall be prohibited.

SECTION 29. Of the funds provided herein to the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning, the following amount shall be allocated to the Delta State University Delta Center for Culture and Learning.....\$ 100,000.00.
The funds allocated in this section shall only be used for the Delta Center for Culture and Learning.

255 This program will provide opportunities for Mississippi's 256 university and college students to gain real-life experience 257 working in Washington, D.C. The funding will provide scholarships 258 at Alcorn State University, Delta State University, Jackson State 259 University, Mississippi State University, Mississippi University 260 for Women, Mississippi Valley State University, the University of 261 Mississippi, and the University of Southern Mississippi. A 262 written report shall be submitted listing the scholarship

265 **SECTION 31.** None of the funds appropriated and/or authorized 266 for expenditure under this act shall be used for research in which 267 a human embryo is killed or destroyed.

268 SECTION 32. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 269 of Section 1 of this act, an amount not more than One Hundred 270 Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be allocated to 271 implement university system efficiencies, including, but not 272 limited to, academic, space, energy and any other system projects 273 or expenditures that would lead to improved efficiency. Such 274 funds may also be used to draw down other funds or as matching 275 funds.

SECTION 33. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of Section 1 of this act, Eighty-seven Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$87,300.00) shall be used to defray the expenses of the Children's Center for Communication and Development at the University of Southern Mississippi.

SECTION 34. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, the amount of Two Hundred Forty-two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$242,500.00) is provided for defraying the expenses of the DuBard School.

285 **SECTION 35.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions 286 of Section 1 of this act, Two Hundred Sixty-six Thousand Seven 287 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$266,750.00) is provided for the Southwest

SECTION 36. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this act, it is the intention of the Legislature that Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) is provided for the Engineer Research and Development Center in Vicksburg, Mississippi, for Research and Development opportunities in Science and Technology initiatives.

296 SECTION 37. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1 of this 297 act, Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000.00) is provided for 298 the Delta State University Delta Music Institute.

299 SECTION 38. It is the intention of the Legislature that 300 Mississippi Valley State University is authorized to provide water 301 or sewer service to any existing, privately-owned structures that 302 presently take water or sewer service from Mississippi Valley 303 State University. Furthermore, Mississippi Valley State 304 University is authorized to charge a flat or metered rate for the 305 service provided. Mississippi Valley State University shall not 306 provide any water or sewer service to any new, privately-owned 307 structures.

308 **SECTION 39.** Of the funds herein appropriated, Seven Hundred 309 Twenty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$729,890.00) 310 shall be provided to the Charter School Authorizer Board. Of this 311 amount, Two Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety 312 Dollars (\$229,890.00) shall be provided in General Funds and Five

The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 317 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 318 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the Institutions of 319 Higher Learning for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure 320 of Capital Expense Funds to defray the expenses of the Institutions of Higher Learning (IHL), acting through the Bureau 321 of Building, Grounds and Real Property Management as authorized in 322 323 SB 2904, 2021 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023.....\$ 324 1,911,895.00.

This appropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of funds for construction and/or repair and renovation projects for the Institutions of Higher Learning as allocated herein:

Delta State University.....\$ 306,335.00 Mississippi Valley State University......\$ 688,116.00 University of Southern Mississippi.....\$ 917,444.00 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance of June 30, 2022.

335 **SECTION 41.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the 336 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 337 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency

338 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 339 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally 340 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for 341 actions contrary to this provision.

342 SECTION 42. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 343 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 344 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 345 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 346 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 347 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 348 SECTION 43. This act shall take effect and be in force from

349 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after 350 June 29, 2022.
