- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be

- 46 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 47 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 49 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 50 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 51 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 52 Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of
- 53 funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered
- 54 under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation
- 55 Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the
- 56 funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the
- 57 minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.
- SECTION 3. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 59 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Five
- 60 Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) is authorized to be
- 61 expended from funds received from the Mississippi Development
- 62 Authority as reimbursements for actual expenses incurred by the
- 63 Office of State Aid Road Construction for administering and
- 64 providing engineering services to political subdivisions as



- 65 authorized under Section 65-4-15, Mississippi Code of 1972. Any
- 66 such funds shall be deposited into the Office of State Aid Roads
- 67 Administrative Fund for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022,
- 68 and ending June 30, 2023.
- 69 **SECTION 4.** Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, it is the
- 70 intention of the Legislature that an amount not to exceed Thirty
- 71 Million Dollars (\$30,000,000.00) is authorized to be expended for
- 72 the purpose of replacement of structurally deficient bridges on
- 73 the Local System Bridge Program (LSBP).
- 74 **SECTION 5.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 75 Office of State Aid Road Construction shall maintain complete
- 76 accounting and personnel records related to the expenditure of all
- 77 funds appropriated under this act and that such records shall be
- 78 in the same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal
- 79 Year 2022. It is further the intention of the Legislature that
- 80 the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2024 shall be
- 81 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format
- 82 and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail
- 83 provided during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request process.
- 84 **SECTION 6.** In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance
- 85 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of
- 86 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized
- 87 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the
- 88 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized,

 Committee for Fiscal Year 2024.
- 140 SECTION 7. With the funds appropriated in this act, the Office of State Aid Road Construction shall notify members of the 141 142 Mississippi Senate and House of Representatives upon the award of 143 projects within their respective districts and at least five (5) 144 days prior to a public ceremony announcing the award of any grant 145 in their district or any public announcement or ceremony regarding 146 the groundbreaking or opening of a facility, roadway or bridge for 147 which the Legislature has made funds available. Any signage 148 regarding any public event or any new facility, roadway or bridge 149 shall include the following language: "Funds were made available 150 for this project by the Mississippi State Legislature." The 151 signage shall further state the four-year legislative term in 152 which the project was funded.
- 153 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature to 154 authorize the State Aid Engineer to utilize funds available to the 155 Office of State Aid Road Construction, from any source herein 156 appropriated or made available by the counties or any other 157 source, to pay for costs necessary to comply with the National 158 Bridge Inspection Standards and the Federal Highway 159 Administration's requirements for bridge inspections and/or 160 special studies necessary to comply with federal laws. Aid Engineer shall follow the same procedures as have heretofore 161

been established by Sections 65-9-9, 65-9-15 and 65-9-17,

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- 163 Mississippi Code of 1972, for payment of such costs. The Office
 164 of State Aid Road Construction may accept, budget and expend these
 165 funds subject to and in accordance with rules and regulations of
 166 the Department of Finance and Administration in a manner
 167 consistent with the escalation of federal or state funds.
 168 SECTION 9. It is the intention of the Legislature that in
 - the letting of contracts for which the Office of State Aid Road
 Construction administers and provides engineering services to
 political subdivisions under the Economic Development Highway Act,
 bids may be made from the lowest and best bidder after advertising
 for competitive sealed bids once in a newspaper published or
 having a circulation in the county or municipality where the
 contract will be performed, and the date published for the bid
 opening may be not less than seven (7) working days after the
 advertisement is published.
- 178 SECTION 10. It is the intention of the Legislature that 179 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 180 181 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 182 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 183 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 184 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 185 made without competitive bids.
- 186 **SECTION 11.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with



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- Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.
- SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after June 29, 2022.
