Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

10 SECTION 1. Chapter 943, Local and Private Laws of 1993, as 11 amended by Chapter 983, Local and Private Laws of 1999, is amended 12 as follows:

13 Section 1. (1) (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection 14 (2) of this section, the governing authorities of the City of 15 Meridian, Mississippi, are authorized, in their discretion, to 16 provide for the payment of minimum monthly benefits of not less 17 than Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) per month from monies 18 accumulated in the Meridian Police and Fire Disability and Relief 19 Fund to all persons now or hereafter entitled to receive benefits

20 under any provision of Section 21-29-101 et seq., Mississippi Code 21 of 1972, by virtue of service as a member of, or through a member 22 of, the fire and/or police department of the City of Meridian.

23 Persons who, on June 30, 1999, are receiving a (b) retirement allowance under Section 21-29-101 et seq. shall receive 24 25 an increase in monthly benefits equal to three and nine-tenths percent (3.9%). If the resulting increased benefit amount is less 26 than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) per month, such benefit amount 27 28 shall be increased to a minimum payment of Six Hundred Dollars 29 (\$600.00) per month. Any retiree, or beneficiary thereof, who retires on or after July 1, 1999, shall receive a benefit in an 30 amount equal to no less than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) per 31 32 month.

33 (c) The governing authorities of the City of Meridian, 34 Mississippi, are authorized to increase, by two percent (2%) every 35 July 1, beginning July 1, 2022, the monthly benefits of persons 36 who, on June 30, 2022, are receiving a retirement allowance under 37 Section 21-29-101 et seq.

38 (d) The governing authorities of the City of Meridian 39 are authorized to levy such millage as is necessary, in addition 40 to any other tax authorized by law, to make the minimum payment 41 provided herein and maintain the retirement fund on a sound 42 actuarial basis. The proceeds of any such additional millage 43 shall be excluded from the ten percent (10%) increase limitation 44 under Section 27-39-321, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the first

45 year of such additional levy and shall be included within such 46 limitation in any year thereafter.

47 Payment of the minimum monthly benefits authorized under (2) subsection (1) of this section shall not be established unless the 48 49 Meridian Police and Fire Disability and Relief Fund is actuarially 50 sound, as shown by the most recent actuarial study required by Section 21-29-119, Mississippi Code of 1972, and the fund will 51 52 remain actuarially sound if the minimum monthly benefits are made, 53 as shown by a certified statement from the actuarial firm that 54 prepared the most recent actuarial study.

55 (3) After the governing authorities of the City of Meridian 56 have adopted a resolution specifying the amount of the minimum 57 monthly benefits authorized under subsection (1) of this section, 58 and the advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-105, 59 Mississippi Code of 1972, has adopted a resolution supporting the 60 payment of the specified amount of the minimum monthly benefits, 61 and after the Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' Retirement System has received these resolutions and the most 62 63 recent actuarial study of the disability and relief fund and the 64 certified statement from the actuarial firm, pursuant to 65 subsection (2) of this section, that the fund will remain 66 actuarially sound if the minimum monthly benefits are paid, then the board of trustees shall pay those benefits to the persons 67 68 authorized and entitled to receive the payments.

99 The governing authorities of the City of Meridian (d) 100 are authorized to levy such millage, in addition to any other tax authorized by law, as is necessary to make the minimum payment 101 102 provided herein and maintain the retirement fund on a sound 103 actuarial basis. The proceeds of any such additional millage 104 shall be excluded from the ten percent (10%) increase limitation under Section 27-39-321, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the first 105 106 year of such additional levy and shall be included within such 107 limitation in any year thereafter.

Payment of the minimum monthly benefits authorized under 108 (2)subsection (1) of this section shall not be established unless the 109 110 Meridian General Municipal Employee Retirement Fund is actuarially sound, as shown by the most recent actuarial study required by 111 112 Section 21-29-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, and the fund will 113 remain actuarially sound if the minimum monthly benefits are made, 114 as shown by a certified statement from the actuarial firm that 115 prepared the most recent actuarial study.

(3) After the governing authorities of the City of Meridian have adopted a resolution specifying the amount of the minimum monthly benefits authorized under subsection (1) of this section,

119 and the advisory board provided for in Section 21-29-9, 120 Mississippi Code of 1972, has adopted a resolution supporting the payment of the specified amount of the minimum monthly benefits, 121 122 and after the Board of Trustees of the Public Employees' 123 Retirement System has received these resolutions and the most 124 recent actuarial study of the disability and relief fund and the certified statement from the actuarial firm, pursuant to 125 126 subsection (2) of this section, that the fund will remain 127 actuarially sound if the minimum monthly benefits are paid, then 128 the board of trustees shall pay those benefits to the persons 129 authorized and entitled to receive the payments.

(4) Persons eligible to receive the minimum monthly benefits
authorized under this section shall receive such payments monthly
effective January 1, 1994. In the event of death of a person or a
beneficiary thereof receiving monthly benefits, any remaining
amounts shall be paid in a lump sum to the designated beneficiary.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER 943, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1993, 2 AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 983, LOCAL AND PRIVATE LAWS OF 1999, TO 3 AUTHORIZE THE GOVERNING AUTHORITIES OF THE CITY OF MERIDIAN, MISSISSIPPI, TO INCREASE, BY 2% EVERY JULY 1, BEGINNING JULY 1, 4 5 2022, THE MONTHLY BENEFITS OF PERSONS WHO, ON JUNE 30, 2022, ARE 6 RECEIVING BENEFITS FROM THE MERIDIAN POLICE AND FIRE DISABILITY 7 AND RELIEF FUND OR THE MERIDIAN GENERAL MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEE 8 RETIREMENT FUND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
