## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1164

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

- 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 57-10-601, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 57-10-601. (1) As used in this section:
- 10 (a) "Act" means the State Small Business Credit
- 11 Initiative Act of 2010 (  $\star$   $\star$  \*12 USC 5701 et seq. as amended).
- 12 (b) "State program" has the meaning ascribed to such
- 13 term in the State Small Business Credit Initiative Act of 2010
- 14 (  $\star$   $\star$  12 USC 5701 et seq. as amended).
- 15 (c) "MDA" means the Mississippi Development Authority.
- 16 (2) The MDA is designated as the agency to implement a state
- 17 program and participate in the State Small Business Credit
- 18 Initiative established under the act.
- 19 (3) The MDA is authorized and empowered to take any action
- 20 necessary to establish and implement a state program that meets
- 21 all the requirements of the act.
- 22 (4) The MDA is authorized and empowered to administer funds
- 23 transferred to the state under the act.

- 24 (5) The Executive Director of MDA \* \* \* shall promulgate and
- 25 put into effect all reasonable rules and regulations that he or
- 26 <u>she</u> may deem necessary to carry out the provisions of this section
- 27 and comply with the act.
- 28 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 29 and after its passage.

## Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
