Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1427

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 SECTION 1. The federal COVID-19 public health emergency 9 continues to create significant exposure and risk to law 10 enforcement officers and firefighters in the State of Mississippi. 11 American Rescue Plan Act funds are specifically targeted toward 12 assisting with premium pay for such public safety workers. The 13 funds provided in this act are necessary expenditures related to 14 COVID-19, the purpose of which is to provide law enforcement 15 officers and firefighters premium pay for their heightened risk during the ongoing federal COVID-19 public health emergency. 16

17 There is created in the State Treasury a **SECTION 2.** (1) 18 special fund to be designated as the "Mississippi Law Enforcement 19 and Firefighters Premium Pay Fund," which shall consist of funds 20 made available by the Legislature in any manner and funds from any 21 other source designated for deposit into such fund. The fund 22 shall be maintained by the State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from the General Fund of the 23 24 state. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a н. в. 1427 PAGE 1

25 fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any 26 investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund 27 shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. Monies in the fund 28 shall be used by the Department of Public Safety, upon 29 appropriation by the Legislature, for the purposes provided in 30 this section. Monies in the fund shall be disbursed in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other 31 32 criteria, as may be amended from time to time, of the United 33 States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from 34 the American Rescue Plan Act. Monies in the fund shall be 35 disbursed by the Department of Public Safety to provide premium pay to certain law enforcement officers and firefighters in the 36 37 State of Mississippi.

38 (2) The Department of Public Safety shall distribute the39 monies in the special fund in accordance with the following:

40 (a) One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of premium pay41 shall be paid to each eligible individual.

42 Eligible individuals are all certified, full-time (b) 43 and part-time law enforcement officers and certified, full-time 44 and part-time firefighters who are serving in the State of 45 Mississippi on the effective date of this act, except those 46 excluded under paragraph (c) of this subsection, and all volunteer firefighters registered with the State of Mississippi or a 47 48 political subdivision thereof on a volunteer firefighting status who have served as a firefighter in the State of Mississippi from 49 50 January 1, 2020, through the effective date of this act. 51 Commissioner of Insurance shall prescribe the criteria for 52 volunteer firefighters to be an eligible individual under this 53 paragraph. If a person is an eligible individual in more than one 54 (1) position covered under this paragraph, that person will only 55 be eligible for one (1) payment of premium pay under paragraph (a) 56 of this subsection.

(c) Any law enforcement officer who received hazard pay
from the Governor's discretionary funds authorized by the
Legislature from the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic
Security Act is not eligible to receive monies under this act.

61 (d) The department also shall distribute monies in the special fund to counties, municipalities and other governmental 62 63 entities that, before the effective date of this act, paid premium 64 pay to law enforcement officers and firefighters employed by them from funds received under the federal American Rescue Plan Act, to 65 66 reimburse those governmental entities for not more than One 67 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) of the amount of premium pay that the governmental entity paid to each recipient. 68

69 (3) The Department of Finance and Administration and the 70 Department of Audit shall have all powers necessary for the 71 implementation of this section.

(4) If the Office of Inspector General of the United States
Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of
any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies
from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds
established by the American Rescue Plan Act (a) determines that
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77 the Department of Public Safety or recipient has expended or 78 otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the Department of Public Safety under this act for any purpose that is not in 79 compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations 80 81 and/or other criteria, as may be amended from time to time, by the 82 United States Department of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds 83 84 established by the American Rescue Plan Act, and (b) the State of 85 Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 86 87 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the Department of Public Safety or recipient, then the Department of Safety or 88 89 recipient, as the case may be, that expended or otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the amount of 90 91 those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to the 92 federal government.

93 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 94 and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed from and after 95 June 30, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
