## Senate Amendments to House Bill No. 1590

TO THE CLERK OF THE HOUSE:

THIS IS TO INFORM YOU THAT THE SENATE HAS ADOPTED THE AMENDMENTS SET OUT BELOW:

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

## Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State Treasury
8	to the credit of the Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy,
9	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the Mississippi State
10	Board of Physical Therapy for the fiscal year beginning
11	July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023\$ 322,025.00.
12	SECTION 2. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
13	of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:

15	Permanent: 3
16	Time-Limited: 0
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
19	Services for Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2023 funds
20	appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
21	added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 budget by the Mississippi
22	Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
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23 personal services appropriation, which shall be published by the 24 State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board 25 shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the 26 27 agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for 28 Fiscal Year 2023 do not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2023 29 30 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions 31 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception 32 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.

33 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 34 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 35 36 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. 37 The 38 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 39 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 40 41 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

46 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
47 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating

H. B. 1590 PAGE 2 48 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 49 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.

56 SECTION 3. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 57 Mississippi State Board of Physical Therapy shall maintain 58 complete accounting and personnel records related to the 59 expenditure of all funds appropriated under this act and that such 60 records shall be in the same format and level of detail as 61 maintained for Fiscal Year 2022. It is further the intention of 62 the Legislature that the agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 63 2024 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee 64 in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2023 budget request 65 66 process.

67 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that 68 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 69 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 70 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 71 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 72 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to

H. B. 1590 PAGE 3 73 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 74 made without competitive bids.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for actions contrary to this provision.

82 SECTION 6. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 83 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 84 85 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 86 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 87 88 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 89 and after July 1, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM SPECIAL FUNDS IN THE 2 STATE TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE 3 MISSISSIPPI STATE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 4 2023.
