This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of Capital Expense Funds previously appropriated by the Legislature in the prior fiscal year for repair, renovation, and improvements of state-owned properties, universities and community colleges.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under the provisions of this section, in no event shall the amount expended exceed the unexpended balance as of June 30, 2022, or change the purpose of which the funds were originally authorized.

149 SECTION 9. The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real Property 150 Management of the Office of General Services is expressly 151 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state,

154 SECTION 10. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 155 156 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 157 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 158 159 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 160 SECTION 11. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed June 29, 2022. 161
