## Adopted COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO

House Bill No. 1664

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

6	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much of it as may be
7	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the Coronavirus
8	State Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the
9	Department of Finance and Administration - Office of Insurance for
10	the purpose of administering the State and School Employees' Life
11	and Health Insurance Plan for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
12	2022, and ending June 30, 2023\$ 0.00.
13	SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section and Section 3 of
14	this act, the term "department" means the Department of Finance
15	and Administration.

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16 (2)The department shall not disburse any funds appropriated 17 under this act to any recipient without first: (a) making an individualized determination that the reimbursement sought is, in 18 the department's independent judgment, for necessary expenditures 19 20 eligible under Section 602 of the federal Social Security Act as 21 added by Section 9901 of the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 22 2021 (ARPA) and its implementing guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be amended or 23 24 supplemented from time to time, by the United States Department of 25 the Treasury; and (b) determining that the recipient has not 26 received and will not receive reimbursement for the expense in 27 question from any source of funds, including insurance proceeds, 28 other than those funds provided under Section 602 of the federal 29 Social Security Act as added by Section 9901 of ARPA. In 30 addition, the department shall ensure that all funds appropriated 31 under this act are disbursed in compliance with the Single Audit 32 Act (31 USC Sections 7501-7507) and the related provisions of the Uniform Guidance, 2 CFR Section 200.303 regarding internal 33 34 controls, Sections 200.330 through 200.332 regarding sub-recipient 35 monitoring and management, and subpart F regarding audit 36 requirements.

37 SECTION 3. (1) As a condition of receiving and expending 38 the funds appropriated to the department under this act, the 39 department shall certify to the Department of Finance and 40 Administration that each expenditure of the funds appropriated to

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41 the department under this act complies with the guidelines, 42 guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as may be 43 amended from time to time, of the United States Department of the 44 Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus State 45 Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA.

46 (2)If the Office of Inspector General of the United States Department of the Treasury, or the Office of Inspector General of 47 48 any other federal agency having oversight over the use of monies 49 from the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by 50 ARPA (a) determines that the department or recipient has expended 51 or otherwise used any of the funds appropriated to the department 52 under this act for any purpose that is not in compliance with the guidelines, guidance, rules, regulations and/or other criteria, as 53 54 may be amended from time to time, of the United States Department 55 of the Treasury regarding the use of monies from the Coronavirus 56 State Fiscal Recovery Fund established by ARPA, and (b) the State 57 of Mississippi is required to repay the federal government for any of those funds that the Office of the Inspector General determined 58 59 were expended or otherwise used improperly by the department or 60 recipient, then the department or recipient that expended or 61 otherwise used those funds improperly shall be required to pay the 62 amount of those funds to the State of Mississippi for repayment to 63 the federal government.

64 **SECTION 4.** The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 65 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the Coronavirus State

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Fiscal Recovery Fund not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his or her warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. SECTION 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2022, and shall stand repealed on June 30, 2022.

Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
