HOUSE BILL NO. 269

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-9-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 INCREASE THE MAXIMUM TOTAL MILEAGE FOR THE STATE AID SYSTEM OF 3 ROADS IN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI BY 400 MILES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. Section 65-9-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 6 7 amended as follows: 65-9-3. (1) There is hereby set up for designation by 8 9 cooperative action of the state and counties a state aid system of 10 roads (including bridges and ferries), as classified and defined in Section 65-9-1, which system shall be designated by the several 11 12 boards of supervisors in their respective counties, with the 13 consent and approval of the State Aid Engineer, to a total mileage 14 not in excess of * * * twenty-six thousand two hundred fifty-seven and four-hundredths (26,257.04) miles not including any municipal 15 16 streets, except that a state aid route may be extended into a 17 municipality in order to make a convenient and orderly connection with the nearest paved or surfaced street or highway capable of 18 19 carrying the traffic originating on or destined for such state aid

- 20 route and thereby making a systematic connection with the highway
- 21 and street systems of the state and its political subdivisions.
- 22 Such system may be modified or revised from time to time by mutual
- 23 agreement between the said boards of supervisors and the State Aid
- 24 Engineer. Mileage on the state aid system shall be allocated to
- 25 the several counties of the state in the following proportions:
- 26 (a) One-third (1/3) shall be allocated to all counties
- 27 in equal shares;
- 28 (b) One-third (1/3) shall be allocated to counties
- 29 based on the proportion that the total number of rural road miles
- 30 in a county bears to the total number of rural road miles in all
- 31 counties of the state; and
- 32 (c) One-third (1/3) shall be allocated to counties
- 33 based on the proportion that the rural population of the county
- 34 bears to the total rural population in all counties of the state,
- 35 according to the latest federal decennial census.
- 36 (2) If the number of miles allocated to any county in
- 37 accordance with the formula specified in subsection (1) of this
- 38 section for any fiscal year after fiscal year 1994 is less than
- 39 the number of miles allocated to that county for fiscal year 1994,
- 40 then each county in that situation shall be allocated an
- 41 additional number of miles that, when added to the number of miles
- 42 allocated to the county in accordance with the formula specified
- 43 in subsection (1) of this section, will be equal to the number of
- 44 miles allocated to the county for fiscal year 1994.

45 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
