## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 273

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE HEALTH CARE IMPACT GRANT PROGRAM TO 2 BE ADMINISTERED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; TO PROVIDE THAT 3 THE PROGRAM SHALL PROVIDE GRANTS TO HOSPITALS AND LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF STRENGTHENING AND IMPROVING THE 5 HEALTH CARE SYSTEM AND THE QUALITY AND AVAILABILITY OF HEALTH CARE 6 SERVICES, AND PARTIALLY COMPENSATING HOSPITALS FOR THE COST OF 7 UNCOMPENSATED CARE THAT THEY HAVE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE AMOUNT OF 8 THE GRANTS SHALL BE CALCULATED BASED ON THE NUMBER OF LICENSED 9 BEDS OF THE HOSPITALS AND LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES; AND FOR 10 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. There is established the Health Care Impact Grant 13 Program to be administered by the State Department of Health. program shall provide grants to hospitals and long-term care 14 15 facilities for the purpose of strengthening and improving the health care system and the quality and availability of health care 16 17 services, and partially compensating hospitals for the cost of uncompensated care that they have. The amount of the grants shall 18 be calculated based on the number of licensed beds of the 19 20 hospitals and long-term care facilities. Hospitals eligible for 21 grants under the program include licensed specialty hospitals that

are recognized as such by the department.
