1 2 3 4	AN ACT TO CREATE THE MOBILE-ONLINE BETTING TASK FORCE; TO PROVIDE THE PURPOSES OF THE TASK FORCE; TO DESIGNATE THE CHAIRPERSON AND CO-CHAIRPERSON OF THE TASK FORCE; TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINTED MEMBERS TO THE TASK FORCE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
6	SECTION 1. (1) There is hereby created the Mobile-Online
7	Betting Task Force to undertake a comprehensive analysis of all
8	matters related to legalizing online betting, online gaming and/or
9	online wagering for a fee within this state and to recommend the
10	proper oversight and regulation of the online betting, online
11	gaming and/or online wagering with a fee. The task force shall be
12	chaired by the House Gaming Committee Chairperson and co-chaired
13	by the Senate Gaming Committee Chairperson and shall be composed
14	of a total of eleven (11) members, with nine (9) members to be
15	appointed as follows:
16	(a) The Executive Director of the Mississippi Gaming
17	Commission or a designee;
18	(b) The Commissioner of the Department of Revenue or a

designee;

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- 20 (c) The Executive Director of the Mississippi Gaming
- 21 and Hospitality Association or a designee;
- 22 (d) Three (3) members appointed by the Chairperson of
- 23 the Senate Gaming Committee; and
- (e) Three (3) members appointed by the Chairperson of
- 25 the House of Representatives Gaming Committee.
- 26 (2) The members of the task force shall be appointed within
- 27 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this act. Any vacancy
- 28 in the task force shall not affect its powers, but shall be filled
- 29 as prescribed in subsection (1). The task force shall hold its
- 30 first meeting within sixty (60) days of the effective date of this
- 31 act, on the call of the Chairman of the task force. A majority of
- 32 the membership of the task force shall constitute a quorum, and
- 33 shall meet at the call of the Chairman, or upon an affirmative
- 34 vote of a majority of the task force. All members must be
- 35 notified in writing of all meetings at least five (5) days before
- 36 the date on which a meeting of the task force is scheduled.
- 37 (3) The members of the task force shall serve without
- 38 compensation.
- 39 (4) The task force shall prepare and submit a final report
- 40 that contains a detailed statement of findings, conclusions and
- 41 recommendations of the task force to the Legislature by October
- 42 15, 2023. The report shall be made available to the public.
- 43 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 44 and after July 1, 2023.
