HOUSE BILL NO. 626

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 19-11-27, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO AUTHORIZE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF ANY COUNTY TO EXPEND OR 3 CONTRACT AN OBLIGATION AGAINST CERTAIN FUNDS IN THE LAST SIX MONTHS OF THEIR TERM OFFICE IF A COUNTY HAS PROJECTS OR A PROJECT 5 FUNDED BY THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) SO THAT SUCH COUNTY 6 MAY WORK TOWARDS COMPLETING SUCH PROJECTS OR PROJECT TO MEET THE 7 YEAR 2026 FEDERAL ARPA SPENDING DEADLINE; AND FOR RELATED 8 PURPOSES.

- 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- SECTION 1. Section 19-11-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 amended as follows:
- 12 19-11-27. No board of supervisors of any county shall expend
- from, or contract an obligation against, the budget estimates for 13
- 14 road and bridge construction, maintenance and equipment, made and
- published by it during the last year of the term of office of such 15
- 16 board, between the first day of October and the first day of the
- following January, a sum exceeding one-fourth (1/4) of such item 17
- of the budget made and published by it, except in cases of 18
- 19 emergency. The clerk of any county is prohibited from issuing any
- 20 warrant contrary to the provisions of this section. No board of
- 21 supervisors nor any member thereof shall buy any machinery or

- 22 equipment in the last six (6) months of their or his term unless
- 23 or until he has been elected at the general election of that year.
- 24 The provisions of this section shall not apply to (i) projects of
- 25 any type that receive monies from the Local System Bridge
- 26 Replacement and Rehabilitation Program, the Emergency Road and
- 27 Bridge Repair Fund, the 2018 Transportation and Infrastructure
- 28 Improvement Fund or the Gulf Coast Restoration Fund * * *, (ii)
- 29 to expenditures on deficient bridges in the State Aid Road System
- 30 or the Local System Road Program that have been deemed to be a
- 31 deficient bridge as defined in Section 65-37-3, (iii) projects
- 32 <u>funded by the American Rescue Plan Act,</u> or <u>(iv)</u>to a contract,
- 33 lease or lease-purchase contract approved by a unanimous vote of
- 34 the board and executed pursuant to the bidding requirements in
- 35 Section 31-7-13 * * *. Such unanimous vote shall include a
- 36 statement indicating the board's proclamation that the award of
- 37 the contract is essential to the efficiency and economy of the
- 38 operation of the county government.
- 39 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 40 and after July 1, 2023.
