## HOUSE BILL NO. 772

- AN ACT TO DESIGNATE THE MISSISSIPPI OPAL AS THE OFFICIAL STATE GEMSTONE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Opal is the only gem found thus far
- 4 to have been naturally produced within the geographical boundaries
- 5 of Mississippi, having been discovered during detailed geological
- 6 mapping of the Catahoula Formation in Claiborne County by the
- 7 Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality, Office of
- 8 Geology; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Opal is a precious gemstone which
- 10 shows brilliant flashes of fire, ranging in color from green to
- 11 red; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the State of Mississippi has yet to designate a
- 13 state gemstone, and the designation of the Mississippi Opal as the
- 14 official state gemstone will encourage pride in our state's rich,
- 15 natural heritage; NOW, THEREFORE,
- 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 17 **SECTION 1.** The Mississippi Opal is hereby designated as the
- 18 official state gemstone of Mississippi.

- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after its passage.
