- 73-15-71. From and after July 1, 2023, the certification of 9
- 10 certified nurse aides (CNAs) shall be administered by the
- Mississippi Board of Nursing instead of the State Department of 11
- Health. The duties of the board for the certification process 12
- shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 13
- 14 (a) Prescribe the requirements for certification and
- 15 recertification of nurse aides;
- (b) Approve training courses for persons to be eligible 16
- 17 to take the certification examination;

18	(c) Administer the certification examination or
19	contract with an administrator to develop, schedule, administer,
20	score and report the results of the certification examination;
21	(d) Issue certifications and renewals of certifications
22	for nurse aides; and
23	(e) Maintaining the Mississippi certified nurse aide
24	registry.
25	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Any position or positions at the State Department
26	of Health whose duties are substantially involved with the
27	administration of certification of CNAs shall be transferred to
28	the Mississippi Board of Nursing.
29	SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from

and after July 1, 2023.
