The Department of Mental Health and community 7 mental health centers shall expand outpatient services and community-based services for former inmates of the Department of 8 9 Corrections who are no longer incarcerated within a correctional 10 institution of the Department of Corrections. The expanded outpatient services and community-based services shall be for such 11 12 former inmates who were diagnosed with a mental illness while 13 housed within a state correctional institution of the Department 14 of Corrections. The expansion of the outpatient services and community-based services shall be paid out of any available funds 15 appropriated for such expansion of services for the former 16 17 incarcerated inmates of the Department of Corrections.
