HOUSE BILL NO. 830

1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A 2 CIVICS CURRICULUM TO BE TAUGHT IN THE PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS; TO 3 AMEND SECTION 37-13-151, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE 4 STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO DEVELOP A HIGH SCHOOL HOME ECONOMICS 5 CURRICULUM; TO AMEND SECTION 37-13-153, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 6 TO REQUIRE SUFFICIENT STATE FUNDING TO BE APPROPRIATED IN THE 7 ADEQUATE EDUCATION PROGRAM AND VOCATIONAL EDUCATION APPROPRIATION BILLS TO PROVIDE FOR NO LESS THAN ONE HOME ECONOMICS INSTRUCTOR IN 8 9 EACH HIGH SCHOOL; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

11 SECTION 1. The State Board of Education shall develop a 12 civics curriculum to be incorporated into the existing curriculum mandated for all public high schools. The civics curriculum must 13 14 be designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills that are critical to the responsibilities of citizenship in the 15 constitutional democracy of the United States. The board shall 16 17 require each school district to implement the civics curriculum in 18 the 2024-2025 school year.

19 SECTION 2. Section 37-13-151, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 20 amended as follows:

The home economics curriculum must include, at a 24 25 minimum, course work in responsible parenting and family living 26 skills. The **\* \* \*** curriculum also must provide instruction to prepare students to understand children's physical, mental, 27 28 emotional and social growth and development as well as to assume 29 responsibility for their care and quidance, with emphasis on nutrition, emotional health and physical health. 30 \* \* \*

31 SECTION 3. Section 37-13-153, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 32 amended as follows:

33 37-13-153. State funding for the home economics programs required in Section 37-13-151 shall be \* \* \* provided in the 34 35 adequate education program and vocational education appropriation 36 bills \* \* \* by line item specifying the amount that is to be 37 expended to employ no less than one (1) instructor in each high school in each school district in the state. Any funds so 38 39 appropriated by line item which are not expended for this purpose 40 in the vocational education appropriation may be expended for 41 other related home economics vocational purposes during the fiscal 42 year for which those funds were appropriated. \* \* \*

43 **SECTION 4.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 44 and after July 1, 2023.
