HOUSE BILL NO. 845

1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE MISSISSIPPI NEW ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT 2 TRAINING ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE OFFICE 3 OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT; TO PROVIDE THAT THE PROGRAM SHALL BE 4 USED BY THE OFFICE OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, WITH THE MISSISSIPPI 5 DEPARTMENT OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY ACTING AS THE FISCAL AGENT, FOR 6 THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING SUPPORT TO COMMUNITY AND JUNIOR COLLEGES 7 FOR THE TRAINING NEEDS THAT MAY ARISE WHEN NEW BUSINESSES LOCATE 8 IN MISSISSIPPI; TO PROVIDE THE CONDITIONS FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR A 9 GRANT; TO PROVIDE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS ABOUT THE PROGRAM FOR THE 10 OFFICE OF WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 11 12 SECTION 1. (1) There is created the Mississippi New 13 Economic Development Training Assistance Grant Program to be administered by the Office of Workforce Development. The grant 14 15 program shall be used by the Office of Workforce Development, with the Mississippi Department of Employment Security acting as the 16 17 fiscal agent, for the purpose of providing support to community and junior colleges for the training needs that may arise when new 18

businesses locate in Mississippi. The grant program shall be 19

20 funded from monies appropriated by the Legislature for that

21 purpose.

(2) The Office of Workforce Development shall prescribe the terms and conditions of grants awarded under the program. In order to receive a grant under the program, a community or junior college must provide the following information to the Office of Workforce Development:

(a) The total amount of funds that will be required;
(b) How the funds will be used by the community or
junior college to support the training needs of the new business;

31 (c) Any other information that the office determines is32 necessary.

33 (3) The Office of Workforce Development may use a maximum of
 34 five percent (5%) of funds appropriated for the program for the
 35 administration of the program.

The Office of Workforce Development shall submit a 36 (4)37 quarterly report on the grant program to the Governor, the 38 Lieutenant Governor, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Chair of the House Workforce Development Committee and the 39 40 Chair of the Senate Economic and Workforce Development Committee. 41 The report shall contain a detailed explanation of how the funds 42 appropriated for the program were awarded, how those grants were 43 used by the community or junior college to support the training needs of the new business, and whether more funds are needed for 44 45 the program. The community or junior college that received grants
