HOUSE BILL NO. 870

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 11-51-85, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE NUMBER OF DAYS A PARTY MAY APPEAL A JUSTICE COURT DECISION TO CIRCUIT COURT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** Section 11-51-85, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 6 amended as follows:
- 7 11-51-85. Either party may appeal to the circuit court of
- 8 the county from the judgment of any justice court judge if appeal
- 9 be demanded and bond given within * * * thirty (30) days after the
- 10 rendition of the judgment. The party taking the appeal shall give
- 11 bond with a sufficient surety, to be approved by the clerk of the
- 12 justice court payable to the opposite party, in the penalty of
- 13 double the amount of the judgment, or double the value of the
- 14 property involved, and all costs accrued and likely to accrue in
- 15 the case, and in no case to be less than One Hundred Dollars
- 16 (\$100.00), conditioned for the payment of such judgment as the
- 17 circuit court may render against him; and the appeal, when
- 18 demanded and bond given, shall operate as a supersedeas of

- 19 execution on such judgment. Any defendant against whom a civil
- 20 judgment may have been entered by a justice court judge who, by
- 21 reason of his poverty, is not able to give bond may nevertheless
- 22 appeal from such judgment on his making an affidavit that, by
- 23 reason of his poverty, he is unable to give bond or other security
- 24 to obtain such appeal, but the appeal in such case shall not
- 25 operate as a supersedeas of the judgment. The clerk of the
- 26 justice court shall at once make up a transcript of the record and
- 27 properly transmit the same to the clerk of the circuit court,
- 28 within fifteen (15) days after the bond has been filed. In
- 29 counties where there is a county court, appeals from justice
- 30 courts shall be to the county court.
- 31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2023.
