HOUSE BILL NO. 894

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 17-1-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 17-1-27. Any person, firm or corporation who shall knowingly
- 9 and * * * willfully violate the terms, conditions or provisions of
- 10 a zoning ordinance adopted under the authority of Sections 17-1-1
- 11 through 17-1-25, inclusive, for violation of which no other
- 12 administrative, civil or criminal penalty is prescribed by state
- or local law, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction
- 14 therefor shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not to exceed One
- 15 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and in case of continuing violations
- 16 without reasonable effort on the part of the defendant to correct
- 17 same, each day the violation continues thereafter shall be a
- 18 separate offense.

- 19 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 20 and after July 1, 2023.
