HOUSE BILL NO. 915

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT A STATE AGENCY, DEPARTMENT, POLITICAL 2 SUBDIVISION OF THIS STATE, COUNTY, MUNICIPALITY, UNIVERSITY, 3 COLLEGE, COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR JUNIOR COLLEGE, OR ANY AGENT, EMPLOYEE OR OFFICER THEREOF FROM CREATING, PLANNING, IMPLEMENTING, 5 ASSISTING, PARTICIPATING IN, OR ENABLING AN OVERSEAS POLICE 6 SERVICE STATION IN LOCATING TO THIS STATE; TO PROVIDE THAT ANY 7 POLICY ADOPTED OR ACTION TAKEN IN VIOLATION OF THIS ACT SHALL BE 8 INVALID AND VOID, AND THE STATION SHALL BE CLOSED IMMEDIATELY BY 9 LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

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- 11 **SECTION 1.** (1) No state agency, department, political
- 12 subdivision of this state, county, municipality, university,
- 13 college, community college or junior college, or any agent,
- 14 employee or officer thereof shall create, plan, implement, assist,
- 15 participate in, or enable any sanctuary policy. For purposes of
- this section, "overseas police service station" means any center 16
- 17 or location managed and/or controlled by any country that is not
- 18 the United States for the purpose of monitoring the activities of
- 19 that country's citizens.
- 20 (2) Any policies that support or regulate overseas police
- service stations in violation of this act shall be invalid and 21

- 22 void upon enactment or adoption. Any overseas police service
- 23 station established in violation of this act shall be closed
- 24 immediately by any law enforcement agency.
- 25 (3) Any state agency, department, political subdivision of
- 26 this state, county, municipality, university, college, community
- 27 college or junior college, or any agent, employee or officer
- 28 thereof found in violation of this act shall be subject to a civil
- 29 penalty of Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00) per day for each
- 30 day that the overseas police service station exists. In order to
- 31 avoid a civil penalty under this section, the state agency,
- 32 department, political subdivision of this state, county,
- 33 municipality, university, college, community college or junior
- 34 college, or any agent, employee or officer thereof shall take
- 35 action to rescind the policy.
- 36 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 2023.
