HOUSE BILL NO. 932

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 97-17-51 AND 97-17-61, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CLARIFY THE CRIMES FOR TAKING THE DOG, CAT OR PET 2 3 OF ANOTHER PERSON; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 97-17-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 5 amended as follows: 6 7 97-17-51. Every person who shall feloniously steal, take and carry away any dog, * * * cat or other pet of another, shall be 8 9 subject to indictment therefor, and on conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars 10 11 (\$500.00), or imprisoned in the county jail not more than six (6) months, or both, or imprisoned in the Penitentiary not less than 12 13 one (1) year nor more than two (2) years. 14 SECTION 2. Section 97-17-61, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 15 amended as follows: 16 97-17-61. Any person who shall, without the consent of the 17 owner or his agent, take away any horse, mare, gelding, mule, 18 jack, jennet, sheep, cow, bull, ox, hog, or other livestock or G1/2H. B. dog, cat, other animal or automobile, truck or other motor 19 20 vehicle, where such taking and carrying away shall not amount to larceny, shall, upon conviction, be fined not exceeding One 21 22 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or be imprisoned not exceeding one 23 (1) year in the county jail, or both. A verdict of guilty of such 24 taking and carrying away may be rendered under an indictment for 25 larceny, if the evidence shall not warrant a verdict of guilty of larceny but shall warrant a conviction under this section. 26 This 27 section shall not apply to anyone who takes such property 28 believing, in good faith, that he has a right to it. The court 29 shall order any person convicted under this section to pay restitution for any damage caused to any property as a result of 30 violating this section. 31

32 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 33 and after July 1, 2023.
