HOUSE BILL NO. 1011

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 73-27-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE LICENSED PODIATRISTS TO PERFORM SURGICAL AND/OR MEDICAL TREATMENT OF THE ANKLE AND GOVERNING STRUCTURES AND TISSUE WHEN THE PODIATRIST HAS MET CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS; TO PROVIDE THAT A 5 LICENSED PODIATRIST MAY PERFORM ANKLE SURGERY ONLY IN AN 6 ACCREDITED HOSPITAL IN WHICH THE PODIATRIST HAS RECEIVED SURGICAL 7 PRIVILEGES TO PERFORM ANKLE SURGERY; TO PROVIDE THAT SURGICAL TREATMENT OF THE ANKLE IS LIMITED TO PROCEDURES LISTED BY THE 8 9 COUNCIL OF PODIATRIC MEDICAL EDUCATION AS BEING REQUIRED FOR GRADUATION AND CERTIFICATION IN REARFOOT AND ANKLE SURGERY; AND 10 11 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 13 SECTION 1. Section 73-27-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 14
- 15 73-27-1. (1) The practice of podiatric medicine is that
- profession concerned with the prevention, examination, diagnosis 16
- and medical, surgical and adjuvant treatment of conditions of the 17
- 18 human foot. For the purposes of this chapter, "foot" means that
- 19 part of the human anatomy which consists of the tarsal bones,
- 20 metatarsal bones and phalanges.
- 21 (2) A podiatrist is a medical care provider who engages in
- 22 the practice of podiatric medicine.

| 23 | (3) A <u>licensed</u> podiatrist may prescribe and administer drugs |

| 24 | and tests, excluding general and spinal anesthesia, that are |
| 25 | essential to the practice of podiatric medicine when used for or |
| 26 | in connection with treatment of disorders of the human foot. |
| 27 | (4) A licensed podiatrist may also perform surgical and/or |
| 28 | medical treatment of the ankle and governing structures and tissue |
| 29 | when the podiatrist: |
| 30 | (a) Has completed a minimum three (3) year post |
| 31 | graduate residency accredited by the Council on Podiatric Medical |
| 32 | Education (CPME); and |
| 33 | (b) Is qualified or certified by the American Board of |
| 34 | Foot and Ankle Surgery (AEFAS) to perform "Reconstructive Rearfoot |
| 35 | and Ankle Surgery" (RPA). |
| 36 | (5) A licensed podiatrist may perform ankle surgery only in |
| 37 | an accredited hospital in which the podiatrist has received |
| 38 | surgical privileges, by the medical staff of that facility, to |
| 39 | perform ankle surgery and other delineation of privileges. For |
| 40 | the purpose of this subsection, an accredited hospital is one that |
| 41 | is actively licensed in Mississippi by the State Department of |
| 42 | Health as an acute care hospital with surgical services available. |
| 43 | (6) Surgical treatment of the ankle is limited to procedures |
| 44 | listed by the Council of Podiatric Medical Education (CPME) in |
| 45 | CPME 320, and their successors, as being required for graduation |
| 46 | and certification in rearfoot and ankle surgery. |

47 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

48 and after July 1, 2023.
