HOUSE BILL NO. 1034

- AN ACT TO BRING FORWARD SECTION 35-1-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH CREATES THE STATE VETERANS AFFAIRS BOARD AND PROVIDES
- 3 FOR ITS COMPOSITION, FOR THE PURPOSES OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND
- 4 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 35-1-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 brought forward as follows:
- 8 35-1-1. (1) (a) There is hereby created a State Veterans
- 9 Affairs Board, which may also be referred to as the "Mississippi
- 10 Veterans Affairs," to consist of seven (7) members, to be
- 11 appointed by the Governor, one (1) from each congressional
- 12 district as they existed on January 1, 1952, of the State of
- 13 Mississippi. One (1) shall be appointed for one (1) year, another
- 14 for two (2) years, another for three (3) years, another for four
- 15 (4) years, another for five (5) years, another for six (6) years,
- 16 and another for seven (7) years, thus staggered. At the end of
- 17 such term for each of said seven (7) members, a successor shall be
- 18 appointed for a term of seven (7) years, thus providing for seven
- 19 (7) members, one (1) of whom shall be appointed each year. In the

- 20 event of death, resignation or removal of a member of the board,
- 21 such person appointed to fill the vacancy shall be a legal
- 22 resident of the congressional district in which the vacancy shall
- 23 occur, and shall serve for the remainder of the term to which such
- 24 member was appointed. Members of the board shall be veterans of
- 25 any war or police action in which the Armed Forces of the United
- 26 States have been, are, or shall be committed for action, who have
- 27 been honorably discharged or honorably released.
- 28 (b) From and after May 14, 1992, terms of all members
- 29 then serving on the State Veterans Affairs Board shall terminate,
- 30 and the board shall be reconstituted as follows: The board shall
- 31 consist of seven (7) members. All members shall be appointed by
- 32 the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. One (1)
- 33 member shall be appointed from each congressional district as such
- 34 districts existed on March 1, 1992, and two (2) members shall be
- 35 appointed from the state at large. Of the initial congressional
- 36 district appointees to the board, one (1) shall serve for a term
- 37 of one (1) year, one (1) for a term of two (2) years, one (1) for
- 38 a term of three (3) years, one (1) for a term of four (4) years
- 39 and one (1) for a term of five (5) years. Of the initial at-large
- 40 appointees, one (1) (who shall be that person appointed in January
- 41 1992 from the First Congressional District under the provisions of
- 42 paragraph (a) of this subsection) shall serve for a term of three
- 43 (3) years and one (1) (who shall be that person appointed in
- 44 January 1992 from the Seventh Congressional District under the

- 45 provisions of paragraph (a) of this subsection) shall serve for a
- 46 term of five (5) years. All appointees after the initial
- 47 appointees shall serve for terms of five (5) years each. In the
- 48 event of death, resignation or removal of a member of the board,
- 49 the vacancy shall be filled by appointment of the Governor, with
- 50 the advice and consent of the Senate, from the congressional
- 51 district in which the vacancy occurs, for the length of the
- 52 unexpired term only. Members of the board shall be honorably
- 53 discharged or released veterans of any war or police action in
- 54 which the Armed Forces of the United States have been, are, or
- 55 shall be committed for action. No state/department commander of
- 56 any federally recognized veterans organization, no national
- 57 officer of any federally recognized veterans organization and no
- 58 member of the Mississippi Council of Veterans Organizations shall
- 59 be eligible for appointment to the board until the expiration of a
- 60 period of three (3) years after the termination of their service
- 61 in such disqualifying positions.
- 62 (2) Members of the board shall annually elect as chairman
- 63 one of their number and another member as vice chairman. Members
- of the board shall hold regular monthly meetings and such other
- 65 meetings as may be called by the chairman or the vice chairman in
- 66 his absence.
- 67 (3) Beginning July 1, 2019, any reference in this code to
- 68 the State Veterans Affairs Board shall also mean the Mississippi
- 69 Veterans Affairs.

70 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 71 and after July 1, 2023.
