HOUSE BILL NO. 1035

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 45-1-12, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE SALARIES OF ALL OFFICERS OF THE MISSISSIPPI HIGHWAY SAFETY PATROL AND THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF NARCOTICS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 45-1-12, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows:

45-1-12. (1) The salaries of all officers of the 8 9 Mississippi Highway Safety Patrol who have completed the course of 10 instruction in an authorized highway patrol training school on general law enforcement, and are serving as a sworn officer of the 11 12 Highway Patrol in the enforcement of the laws of the State of Mississippi, including service in any other division of the 13 Department of Public Safety, and the sworn law enforcement 14 officers of the Mississippi Bureau of Narcotics, shall be 15 determined and paid in accordance with the scale for officers 16 17 salaries as provided in this subsection:

70 shall be paid a salary in accordance with the above scale. 71 Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any 72 rank of any sworn officer not based upon a merit-based promotion 73 or years of experience shall be at the will and pleasure of the 74 appointing authority as approved by the State Personnel Board. 75 The rank and years of experience of each sworn officer to be used 76 in establishing the salary shall be determined by the rank and 77 years of experience on July 1 of the current fiscal year.

78 (3) For purposes of applying the rank designation to the 79 above scale, the following job classifications of the State 80 Personnel Board shall be applicable for the Mississippi Highway 81 Patrol:

(5) In any fiscal year after July 1, 2015, in the event the Legislature provides across-the-board salary increases to state employees whose compensation is paid from the State General Fund and subject to specific appropriation therefor by the Legislature, the State Personnel Board shall revise the salary scale above to provide the same percentage or dollar amount increase as has been appropriated for other state employees.

134 It shall be the duty of the Mississippi Department of (6)135 Public Safety to file with the Legislative Budget Office and the 136 State Fiscal Officer such data and information as may be required to enable the said Legislative Budget Office and State Fiscal 137 138 Officer to budget and distribute the funds necessary to compensate 139 the sworn officers of the Department of Public Safety according to 140 the requirements of the salary scale. Such data and information 141 so filed may be revised from time to time as necessitated to 142 reflect the current number and experience of sworn officers employed by the department. 143

144 (7) The Commissioner of Public Safety, with approval by the 145 State Personnel Board, is authorized to set the salaries equitably 146 of sworn law enforcement officers assigned to the Commercial 147 Transportation Enforcement Division and Capitol Police based upon 148 the pay scale contained in this section.

149 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 150 and after July 1, 2023.
