COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 1048

1 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE UNIVERSAL CHANGING TABLES 2 INSTALLATION INCENTIVE GRANT PROGRAM ACT FOR THE PURPOSES OF 3 CREATING FINANCIAL INCENTIVES TO PUBLIC AND PRIVATE OR COMMERCIAL 4 ENTITIES LOCATED WITHIN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI TO INSTALL 5 UNIVERSAL CHANGING TABLES WITHIN THE RESTROOM OF FACILITIES UNDER 6 THEIR CONTROL; TO PROVIDE THAT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF 7 REHABILITATION SERVICES SHALL ADMINISTER THE PROGRAM; TO PROVIDE THAT GRANTS SHALL BE FUNDED FROM MONIES APPROPRIATED BY THE 8 9 LEGISLATURE AND ANY OTHER SOURCES OF FUNDS MADE AVAILABLE TO THE DEPARTMENT FOR THAT PURPOSE; TO PROVIDE THAT THE GRANTS SHALL BE 10 11 AWARDED SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE FUNDING; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 13 SECTION 1. This act shall be known and cited as the "Universal Changing Tables Installation Incentive Grant Program 14

15 Act."

16 <u>SECTION 2.</u> (1) There is established the Universal Changing 17 Tables Installation Incentive Grant Program for the purpose and 18 intent of providing financial assistance to public and private or 19 commercial entities located within the State of Mississippi to 20 install universal changing tables in one or more restrooms in 21 existing or proposed facilities under its control.

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22 (2)Any state agency, department, municipal or county 23 governing authority exercising ownership and control over any public facility or the owner of any private or commercial building 24 25 which is accessible to the public, may be entitled to receive 26 grants up to a maximum amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) 27 for each universal changing table installed in one or more restrooms in existing or proposed facilities under its control. 28 29 Based upon a determination by the Mississippi Department of 30 Rehabilitation Services, relative to the funds made available for 31 the awarding of grants for the purpose specified in this act, the 32 department may increase or decrease the number of grants awarded accordingly under the authority prescribed in Section 3 of this 33 34 act.

(3) Grants shall be funded from monies appropriated by the Legislature to the department for that purpose, or any other source of funding made available to the department for purposes of this act. Grants shall be awarded on the basis of available funds on a first-come, first-served basis, provided that grant applicants satisfy the criteria established by the department for the awarding of grants.

42 (4) To cover the costs of administering the grant program in 43 accordance with this act, the Department of Rehabilitation 44 Services may receive up to one percent (1%) of any annual 45 appropriation received by the department for the awarding of 46 grants.

47 <u>SECTION 3.</u> (1) The Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation
48 Services shall administer the Universal Changing Tables
49 Installation Incentive Grant Program and shall have the following
50 powers and duties:

51 (a) Receiving applications for grants under the grant52 program;

53 (b) Determining the eligibility of applicants and54 paying the grants from any funds available;

(c) Adopting and enforcing appropriate rules and regulations regarding forms designed to be used by applicants for grants and the eligibility of applicants;

(d) Developing criteria for evaluating the growing need
for the installation of universal changing tables, including, but
not be limited to:

61 (i) The percentage of the state's population62 living with a physical disability; and

(ii) The number of existing public and private or
 commercial facilities currently equipped with a universal changing
 table;

66 (e) Developing the administrative policy for the grant67 program;

(f) Promulgating rules and regulations pertaining tothe implementation and operation of the grant program;

76 Collaborating with the Department of Archives and (j) 77 History and the Department of Finance and Administration to ensure 78 that the integrity of facilities designated as historic landmarks 79 is not compromised by the installation of a universal changing table within such facilities. 80

81 When reviewing applications for grant awards, the (2)82 department shall give priority to applicants whose applications specify that in the installation of the universal changing table, 83 the table is: 84

85 (a) Powered and height-adjustable, for safety of the 86 person and caregiver assisting;

87 Placed in single occupancy restrooms, universal to (b) 88 gender;

Placed in a room with a minimum size of at least 89 (C) 90 ten (10) feet by fourteen and six-tenths (14.6) feet, which allows 91 for a turning radius of sixty (60) inches for the wheelchair in the middle of the room and thirty-six (36) inches of space at one 92 93 (1) end of the table; and

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94 (d) Made known to the visitors by the placement of95 clearly visible signage at the entrance of the building.

96 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 97 and after July 1, 2023.

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
