## HOUSE BILL NO. 1070 (As Passed the House)

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW SECTION 37-13-187, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO ESTABLISH THE PATRIOTIC EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM TO BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING EDUCATION THAT <u>TEACHES</u> AMERICAN HISTORY IN SCHOOLS; TO PROVIDE CERTAIN STANDARDS FOR THE GRANT PROGRAM; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROMULGATE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE PROGRAM; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE ANNUAL GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF FIVE MILLION DOLLARS TO THE PATRIOTIC EDUCATION GRANT PROGRAM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 11 **SECTION 1.** The following shall be codified as Section
- 12 37-13-187, Mississippi Code of 1972:
- 13 37-13-187. (1) There is hereby established the Patriotic
- 14 Education Grant Program.
- 15 (2) The Patriotic Education Grant Program shall be
- 16 administered by the Department of Education for the purpose of
- 17 promoting education that teaches American history in schools.
- 18 (3) The Department of Education shall administer grant funds
- 19 to schools for activities, including but not limited to,
- 20 after-school clubs, special speakers and field trips.

- 21 (4) All school districts and teachers may apply for grant
- 22 funds from the program, provided that teachers shall receive
- 23 approval from their school district before applying for such
- 24 funds. If a teacher submits an application for a grant under the
- 25 program, he or she must specify the purposes for which the funds
- 26 are intended for use. If the teacher's grant application is
- 27 approved, the funds shall be issued to the school district of the
- 28 teacher's employment for the uses specified in the application,
- 29 and expenditures of which must be reported to the appropriate
- 30 district personnel responsible for receivable and expendable
- 31 accounts.
- 32 (5) The Department of Education shall promulgate rules and
- 33 regulations to accomplish the purpose of the program.
- 34 (6) The Department of Education shall allocate annual grant
- 35 funding in the amount of Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00) to
- 36 the Patriotic Education Grant Program. There is created a special
- 37 fund in the State Treasury, to be known as the "Patriotic
- 38 Education Grant Fund," from which the grants authorized by this
- 39 act shall be disbursed by the Department of Education.
- 40 (7) All monies deposited into the Patriotic Education Grant
- 41 Fund shall be exclusively used for the purposes provided in this
- 42 act and any unspent funds at the end of the fiscal year shall not
- 43 revert to the General Fund of the State Treasury but shall be
- 44 available for such purposes in subsequent fiscal years.

45 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

46 and after July 1, 2023.
