54 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 55 SECTION 1. Section 27-104-371, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 56 amended as follows:

57 27 - 104 - 371. (1) A special fund, to be designated as the "2022 Local Improvements Projects Fund," is created within the 58 59 State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State 60 Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from 61 the General Fund of the state. Unexpended amounts remaining in 62 the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the 63 State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings 64 on amounts in the fund shall be deposited into such fund.

65 (2) Monies deposited into the fund shall be disbursed by the

(2) (a) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a special fund to be designated as the "Small Municipalities and Limited Population Counties Fund," which shall consist of funds
