1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 27-104-371, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972,
2 TO REVISE THE LANGUAGE OF SEVERAL PROJECTS FUNDED FROM THE 2022
3 LOCAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECTS FUND; TO AMEND SECTIONS 1 AND 4,
4 CHAPTER 103, LAWS OF 2022, TO PROVIDE THAT THE FUNDING FOR THE
5 MISSISSIPPI LAW ENFORCEMENT AND FIRE FIGHTERS PREMIUM PAY PROGRAM
6 WILL BE FROM THE CORONAVIRUS STATE FISCAL RECOVERY LOST REVENUE
7 FUND INSTEAD OF THE CORONAVIRUS STATE FISCAL RECOVERY FUND; TO
8 AMEND SECTION 7, CHAPTER 9, LAWS OF 2022, TO REVISE THE FISCAL
9 YEAR 2023 APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE BOARD OF PSYCHOLOGY TO
10 INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF FUNDS PROVIDED FOR THE ADMINISTRATIVE
11 SUPPORT OF THE MISSISSIPPI AUTISM BOARD; TO AMEND SECTION 15,
12 CHAPTER 74, LAWS OF 2022, TO REVISE THE FISCAL YEAR 2023
13 APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI AUTHORITY FOR EDUCATIONAL
14 TELEVISION TO CLARIFY THAT THE FUNDS REAPPROPRIATED TO PROVIDE FOR

33 PROVIDED IN THIS ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 2, CHAPTER 109, LAWS OF
34 2022, TO REVISE THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 APPROPRIATION TO THE



35 MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO REMOVE THE FUNDS
36 REAPPROPRIATED FROM THE GULF COAST RESTORATION FUND TO ASSIST THE
37 HANCOCK COUNTY PORT AND HARBOR COMMISSION WITH THE ASSAULT LANDING
38 STRIP; TO AMEND SECTION 3, CHAPTER 109, LAWS OF 2022, TO REVISE
39 THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT
40 AUTHORITY TO REMOVE THE FUNDS REAPPROPRIATED FROM THE GULF COAST
41 RESTORATION FUND TO ASSIST THE HANCOCK COUNTY PORT AND HARBOR
42 COMMISSION WITH THE MULTIUSER AERO STRIP AT STENNIS AIRPORT; TO
43 CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE KNOWN AS THE
44 2022 MISSISSIPPI PORTS IMPROVEMENTS FUND, WHICH SHALL BE EXPENDED
45 BY THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY UPON APPROPRIATION BY THE
46 LEGISLATURE; TO CREATE A SPECIAL FUND IN THE STATE TREASURY TO BE
47 KNOWN AS THE 2022 MISSISSIPPI LAND, WATER, AND TIMBER RESOURCES
48 FUND, WHICH SHALL BE EXPENDED BY THE MISSISSIPPI LAND, WATER AND
49 TIMBER RESOURCES BOARD UPON APPROPRIATION BY THE LEGISLATURE; TO
50 BRING FORWARD SECTION 57-1-18, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, WHICH
51 CREATED THE SMALL MUNICIPALITIES AND LIMITED POPULATION COUNTIES
52 FUND, FOR THE PURPOSE OF POSSIBLE AMENDMENT; AND FOR RELATED
53 PURPOSES.

54 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

55 **SECTION 1.** Section 27-104-371, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
56 amended as follows:

57 27-104-371. (1) A special fund, to be designated as the
58 "2022 Local Improvements Projects Fund," is created within the
59 State Treasury. The fund shall be maintained by the State
60 Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart from
61 the General Fund of the state. Unexpended amounts remaining in
62 the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the
63 State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings
64 on amounts in the fund shall be deposited into such fund.

65 (2) Monies deposited into the fund shall be disbursed by the
66 Department of Finance and Administration as follows:

67 (a) To the Department of Archives and History for the
68 purpose of providing a grant to the Scott Ford House, Inc., to
69 develop the property located at 136 East Cohea Street in the City



70 of Jackson, the home of the former slave Mary Scott Green, to tell
71 her story and that of other Mississippi midwives, and to develop
72 the property located at 138 East Cohea Street in the City of
73 Jackson as a house museum to tell the family story of the midwife

1388 **SECTION 11.** There is created in the State Treasury a special
1389 fund to be known as the 2022 Mississippi Ports Improvements Fund,
1390 which shall consist of funds made available by the Legislature in
1391 any manner and funds from any other source designated for deposit
1392 into the fund. Monies in the fund shall be used by the
1393 Mississippi Development Authority, upon appropriation by the
1394 Legislature, for such purposes as provided in the appropriation.
1395 Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal
1396 year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest
1397 earned or investment earnings on amounts in the fund shall be
1398 deposited to the credit of the fund.

1399 **SECTION 12.** There is created in the State Treasury a special
1400 fund to be known as the 2022 Mississippi Land, Water, and Timber
1401 Resources Fund, which shall consist of funds made available by the
1402 Legislature in any manner and funds from any other source
1403 designated for deposit into the fund. Monies in the fund shall be
1404 used by the Mississippi Land, Water and Timber Resources Board,
1405 upon appropriation by the Legislature, for such purposes as
1406 provided in the appropriation. Unexpended amounts remaining in
1407 the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse into the
1408 State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment earnings
1409 on amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the
1410 fund.



1411 **SECTION 13.** Section 57-1-18, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
1412 brought forward as follows:

1413 57-1-18. (1) For the purposes of this section, the
1414 following terms shall have the meanings ascribed in this section
1415 unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

1416 (a) "Limited population county" means a county in the
1417 State of Mississippi with a population of thirty thousand (30,000)
1418 or less according to the most recent federal decennial census at
1419 the time the county submits its application to the MDA under this
1420 section.

1421 (b) "MDA" means the Mississippi Development Authority.

1422 (c) "Project" means highways, streets and other
1423 roadways, bridges, sidewalks, utilities, airfields, airports,
1424 acquisition of equipment, acquisition of real property,
1425 development of real property, improvements to real property, and
1426 any other project approved by the MDA.

1427 (d) "Small municipality" means a municipality in the
1428 State of Mississippi with a population of ten thousand (10,000) or
1429 less according to the most recent federal decennial census at the
1430 time the municipality submits its application to the MDA under
1431 this section. The term "small municipality" also includes a
1432 municipal historical hamlet as defined in Section 17-27-5.

1433 (2) (a) There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
1434 special fund to be designated as the "Small Municipalities and
1435 Limited Population Counties Fund," which shall consist of funds



1436 appropriated or otherwise made available by the Legislature in any
1437 manner and funds from any other source designated for deposit into
1438 such fund. Unexpended amounts remaining in the fund at the end of
1439 a fiscal year shall not lapse into the State General Fund, and any
1440 investment earnings or interest earned on amounts in the fund
1441 shall be deposited to the credit of the fund. Monies in the fund
1442 shall be used to make grants to small municipalities and limited
1443 population counties or natural gas districts created by law and
1444 contained therein to assist in completing projects under this
1445 section.

1446 (b) Monies in the fund which are derived from proceeds
1447 of bonds issued under Sections 1 through 16 of Chapter 538, Laws
1448 of 2002, Sections 1 through 16 of Chapter 508, Laws of 2003,
1449 Sections 55 through 70 of Chapter 1, Laws of 2004 Third
1450 Extraordinary Session, Sections 1 through 16 of Chapter 482, Laws
1451 of 2006, Section 15 of Chapter 580, Laws of 2007, Section 1 of
1452 Chapter 503, Laws of 2008, Section 42 of Chapter 557, Laws of
1453 2009, Section 38 of Chapter 533, Laws of 2010, Section 41 of
1454 Chapter 480, Laws of 2011, Section 30 of Chapter 569, Laws of
1455 2013, Section 4 of Chapter 530, Laws of 2014, Section 11 of
1456 Chapter 472, Laws of 2015, Section 19 of Chapter 511, Laws of
1457 2016, Section 5 of Chapter 452, Laws of 2018, Section 19 of
1458 Chapter 454, Laws of 2019, or Section 11 of Chapter 492, Laws of
1459 2020, may be used to reimburse reasonable actual and necessary
1460 costs incurred by the MDA for the administration of the various



1461 grant, loan and financial incentive programs administered by the
1462 MDA. An accounting of actual costs incurred for which
1463 reimbursement is sought shall be maintained by the MDA.
1464 Reimbursement of reasonable actual and necessary costs shall not
1465 exceed three percent (3%) of the proceeds of bonds issued.
1466 Reimbursements under this subsection shall satisfy any applicable
1467 federal tax law requirements.

1468 (3) The MDA shall establish a grant program to make grants
1469 to small municipalities and limited population counties from the
1470 Small Municipalities and Limited Population Counties Fund. Grants
1471 made under this section to a small municipality or a limited
1472 population county shall not exceed Two Hundred Fifty Thousand
1473 Dollars (\$250,000.00) during any grant period established by the
1474 MDA. A small municipality or limited population county may apply
1475 to the MDA for a grant under this section in the manner provided
1476 for in this section.

1477 (4) A small municipality or limited population county
1478 desiring assistance under this section must submit an application
1479 to the MDA. The application must include a description of the
1480 project for which assistance is requested, the cost of the project
1481 for which assistance is requested, the amount of assistance
1482 requested and any other information required by the MDA.

1483 (5) The MDA shall have all powers necessary to implement and
1484 administer the program established under this section, and the
1485 department shall promulgate rules and regulations, in accordance



1486 with the Mississippi Administrative Procedures Law, necessary for
1487 the implementation of this section.

1488 (6) The MDA shall file an annual report with the Governor,
1489 the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of
1490 Representatives not later than December 1 of each year, describing
1491 all assistance provided under this section.

1492 **SECTION 14.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
1493 and after its passage.
