## HOUSE BILL NO. 1111 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 93-15-105, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO AUTHORIZE YOUTH COURT, IN ABUSE OR NEGLECT PROCEEDINGS, TO HAVE ORIGINAL, EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION OF BOTH VOLUNTARY AND INVOLUNTARY TERMINATION OF PARENTAL RIGHTS ACTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 93-15-105, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 8 93-15-105. (1) The chancery court has original exclusive
- 9 jurisdiction over all termination of parental rights proceedings
- 10 except when a county court sitting as a youth court has acquired
- 11 jurisdiction of a child in an abuse or neglect proceeding, then
- 12 the county court shall have original exclusive jurisdiction to
- 13 hear \* \* \* petitions for both voluntary and involuntary
- 14 termination of parental rights actions against a parent of that
- 15 child pursuant to the procedures of this chapter.
- 16 (2) (a) Venue in a county court sitting as a youth court
- 17 for any termination of parental rights proceedings shall be in the
- 18 county in which the court has jurisdiction of the child in the
- 19 abuse or neglect proceedings. Venue in chancery court for

- 20 termination of parental rights proceedings shall be proper either
- 21 in the county in which the defendant resides, the child resides or
- 22 in the county where an agency or institution having custody of the
- 23 child is located.
- 24 (b) Transfers of venue shall be governed by the
- 25 Mississippi Rules of Civil Procedure.
- 26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 27 and after July 1, 2023.
