HOUSE BILL NO. 1181

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 23-15-851, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT IF A VACANCY OCCURS TWELVE MONTHS BEFORE THE GENERAL ELECTION FOR STATE OFFICERS IS HELD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL NOT ISSUE A WRIT OF ELECTION TO FILL THE VACANCY; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 23-15-851, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows:

9 23-15-851. (1) Except as otherwise provided in subsection 10 (2) of this section, within thirty (30) days after vacancies occur in either house of the Legislature, the Governor shall issue writs 11 12 of election to fill the vacancies on a day specified in the writ of election. At least sixty (60) days' notice shall be given of 13 the election in each county or part of a county in which the 14 15 election shall be held. The qualifying deadline for the election 16 shall be fifty (50) days before the election. Notice of the 17 election shall be posted at the courthouse and in each supervisors district in the county or part of county in which such election 18 19 shall be held for as near sixty (60) days as may be practicable.

(2) If a vacancy occurs * * * twelve (12) months before the
general election for state officers is held, the Governor * * *
<u>shall</u> not * * * issue a writ of election to fill the vacancy.
SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
and after July 1, 2023.
