HOUSE BILL NO. 1192

- 1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 57-26-5, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
- 2 EXTEND THE AUTHORITY OF THE MISSISSIPPI DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY TO
- 3 ISSUE A CERTIFICATE DESIGNATING AN ENTITY AS AN APPROVED
- PARTICIPANT AND AUTHORIZING THE APPROVED PARTICIPANT TO
- 5 PARTICIPATE IN THE TOURISM PROJECT SALES TAX INCENTIVE PROGRAM;
- AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 8 SECTION 1. Section 57-26-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- amended as follows: 9
- 10 57-26-5. (1) The MDA shall develop, implement and
- 11 administer the incentive program authorized in Sections 57-26-1
- 12 through 57-26-5 and shall promulgate rules and regulations
- 13 necessary for the development, implementation and administration
- 14 of such program.
- 15 (2) A person, corporation or other entity desiring to
- participate in the incentive program authorized in Sections 16
- 57-26-1 through 57-26-5 must submit an application and an 17
- 18 application fee in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00)
- 19 to the MDA. Such application must contain (a) plans for the
- 20 proposed tourism project; (b) a detailed description of the

21 proposed tourism project; (c) the method of financing the proposed 22 tourism project and the terms of such financing; (d) an independent study that identifies the number of out-of-state 23 visitors anticipated to visit the project and the ratio of 24 25 out-of-state visitors to in-state visitors; and (e) any other 26 information required by the MDA. The Executive Director of the 27 MDA shall review the application and determine if it qualifies as 28 a tourism project under this section and under the rules and 29 regulations promulgated pursuant to this section. 30 executive director determines the proposed tourism project 31 qualifies as a tourism project under this section and under the 32 rules and regulations promulgated pursuant to this section, he 33 shall issue a certificate to the person, corporation or other entity designating such person, corporation or other entity as an 34 35 approved participant and authorizing the approved participant to 36 participate in the incentive program provided for in Sections 37 57-26-1 through 57-26-5. No certificate designating an entity as an approved participant and authorizing the approved participant 38 39 to participate in the incentive program shall be issued from and 40 after July 1, 2014, for tourism projects that are cultural retail attractions, or from and after July 1, * * * 2026, for other 41 42 tourism projects. For tourism projects that are cultural retail attractions, no such issued certificate shall be altered or 43

extended after the date last approved as of July 1, 2020.

45	(3) The MDA shall cause a cost-benefit analysis of the
46	tourism project to be performed by a state institution of higher
47	learning, the university research center or some other entity
48	approved by the MDA.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2023.
