6 **SECTION 1.** Section 17-1-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

7 amended as follows:

8 17-1-27. Any person, firm or corporation who shall knowingly

9 and \* \* \* willfully violate the terms, conditions or provisions of

10 a zoning ordinance adopted under the authority of Sections 17-1-1

11 through 17-1-25, inclusive, for violation of which no other

12 administrative, civil or criminal penalty is prescribed by state

13 or local law, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction

14 therefor shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not to exceed One

15 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and in case of continuing violations

16 without reasonable effort on the part of the defendant to correct

17 same, each day the violation continues thereafter shall be a

18 separate offense.
