- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mississippi Legislature finds the
- 7 following:
- 8 (a) Feminine hygiene products are a health care
- 9 necessity and not an item that can be foregone or substituted
- 10 easily;
- 11 (b) Access to feminine hygiene products is a serious
- 12 and ongoing need in this state;
- 13 (c) When students do not have access to affordable
- 14 feminine hygiene products, they may miss multiple days of school
- 15 every month; and
- 16 (d) When students have access to quality feminine
- 17 hygiene products, they are able to continue with their daily lives
- 18 with minimal interruption.

19	(2) As	used	in	this	section	the	following	terms	shall	have
20	the meaning ascribed			here	in:						

- 21 (a) "Feminine hygiene products" means tampons and 22 sanitary napkins for use in connection with the menstrual cycle.
- 23 (b) "School building" means any facility:
- 24 (i) That is owned or leased by the school district
- 25 or over which the board has care, custody and control; and
- 26 (ii) In which there is a public school serving
- 27 students in Grade 6 through Grade 12.
- 28 (3) School districts are authorized to make feminine hygiene
- 29 products available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms or
- 30 offices of the school nurse in school buildings.
- 31 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 32 and after July 1, 2023.
