HOUSE BILL NO. 1606

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FROM GENERAL FUND IN THE STATE 2 TREASURY FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE STATE 3 FIRE ACADEMY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 6 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the State Fire Academy for the fiscal year beginning 8 9 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 5,324,164.00. SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of 10 11 Section 1, the following positions are authorized: 12 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT: Permanent: Full Time..... 13 60 14 Time-Limited: Full Time..... 0 With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's 15 16 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal 17 Services for Fiscal Year 2025 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2024 funds 18 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are

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19 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 budget by the Mississippi 20 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's personal services appropriation, which shall be published by the 21 22 State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board 23 shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll costs 24 based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for 25 26 Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed the data provided by the 27 Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 28 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions 29 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception 30 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.

31 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 32 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State 33 34 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written 35 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written 36 37 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions 38 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the 39 appropriated level.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

H. B. No. 1606 **~ OFFICIAL ~** 23/HR13/A502 PAGE 2 44 None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in 45 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating 46 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as 47 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.

Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.

54 SECTION 3. In compliance with the "Mississippi Performance 55 Budget and Strategic Planning Act of 1994," it is the intent of 56 the Legislature that the funds provided herein shall be utilized 57 in the most efficient and effective manner possible to achieve the 58 intended mission of this agency. Based on the funding authorized, 59 this agency shall make every effort to attain the targeted 60 performance measures provided below:

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agency's budget request submitted to the Joint Legislative BudgetCommittee for Fiscal Year 2025.

70 SECTION 4. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 71 State Fire Academy shall maintain complete accounting and 72 personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds 73 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the 74 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year 75 2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the 76 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to 77 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of 78 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided 79 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.

80 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the 81 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 82 83 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 84 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 85 86 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are 87 made without competitive bids.

88 SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 89 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with 90 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency 91 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their 92 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally

95 SECTION 7. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital 96 97 Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the State Fire 98 Academy for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of Capital Expense Funds for the purpose of a state match to purchase 99 100 a specialty rescue truck, as authorized in House Bill No. 1594, 101 2022 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 102 75,000.00.

Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section, the amount that may be expended under the authority of this section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds remaining as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

109 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 110 State Fire Academy is hereby authorized to pay invoices submitted 111 by Aramark Uniform for reimbursement for prior fiscal year 112 commodities in an amount not to exceed Five Thousand Six Hundred 113 Fourteen Dollars (\$5,614.00).

114 **SECTION 9.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 115 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 116 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 117 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal

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Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. SECTION 10. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2023.

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
