1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING THE 2 EXPENSES AND PROVIDING CONTINGENT FUNDS FOR THE LEGISLATURE, THE 3 EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE BUDGET COMMITTEE, THE EXPENSES 4 OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE EVALUATION AND 5 EXPENDITURE REVIEW, THE EXPENSES OF THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE 6 REAPPORTIONMENT COMMITTEE, THE EXPENSES OF THE JOINT COMMITTEE ON 7 COMPILATION, REVISION AND PUBLICATION OF LEGISLATION, PAYING THE 8 MONTHLY EXPENSE ALLOWANCE OF THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE, 9 PAYING THE STATE'S SHARE OF VARIOUS ASSESSMENTS, AND FOR RELATED 10 PURPOSES, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024. 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 12 SECTION 1. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be 13 necessary, are appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying 14 15 salaries, mileage, insurance, matching funds and the daily expense allowance of the members of the Legislature for the Regular 16 17 Session of 2024 and providing contingent funds for the House of Representatives and Senate for the fiscal year beginning 18 July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, as follows: 19 20 For salaries, mileage, insurance, 21 matching funds and daily 22 expense allowance of members A1/2 H.  For Contingent Fund for the

Out of the above amount appropriated for the Contingent Fund for the House of Representatives, not more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) shall be expended for defraying the expenses of and for the use of the members of the Mississippi Commission on Interstate Cooperation, as created under Section 5-5-1 et seq.,

54 The Joint Legislative Reapportionment Committee shall 55 prepare, publish and provide semiannual reports to each member of 56 the Legislature and such reports shall provide a line-by-line 57 detailed accounting of all receipts and expenditures of any and 58 all monies appropriated by the Legislature to the Joint 59 Legislative Reapportionment Committee. Any meetings of the Joint 60 Legislative Reapportionment Committee shall be held in state 61 offices or at publicly owned facilities.

SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying the monthly expense allowance of the members of the Legislature, as provided in Section 5-1-41, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024, as follows:

For the Senate.....\$ 1,039,050.00.
SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
necessary is appropriated out of any money in the State General

It is the intention of the Legislature that whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this Legislature for 90 91 the purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things 92 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price, 93 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind 94 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to 95 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are made without competitive bids. 96

None of the funds appropriated under the 98 provisions of this act may be used to pay or reimburse any 99 expenses of out-of-state travel for any member or employee of the 100 House of Representatives without prior approval of the House 101 Management Committee or for any member or employee of the Senate 102 without prior approval of the Senate Rules Committee.

103 SECTION 7. Of the funds provided herein, the Clerk of the 104 Mississippi House of Representatives and the Secretary of the 105 Mississippi Senate may transfer funds between accounts for their 106 respective chambers which are administered by the Mississippi 107 House of Representatives and the Mississippi Senate.

108 The money herein appropriated shall be paid by SECTION 8. 109 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 110 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 111 112 Officer shall issue warrants upon requisitions signed by the 113 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law. 114 SECTION 9. This act shall take effect and be in force from 115 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2023.
