HOUSE BILL NO. 1611 (As Sent to Governor)

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI ARTS COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General
7	Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the
8	expenses of the Mississippi Arts Commission for the fiscal year
9	beginning July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024
10	\$ 1,528,431.00.
11	SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
12	necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in
13	the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Arts
14	Commission which is comprised of special source funds and
15	donations collected by or otherwise available to the commission,
16	for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the commission for
17	the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
18	June 30, 2024\$ 8,606,470.00.

19 **SECTION 3.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of

20 this act, the following positions are authorized:

- 21 AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
- Permanent: 10
- 23 Time-Limited: 2
- With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
- 25 responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal
- 26 Services for Fiscal Year 2025 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2024 funds
- 27 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
- 28 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 budget by the Mississippi
- 29 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
- 30 personal services appropriation, which the State Personnel Board
- 31 shall publish. The agency's personal services appropriation may
- 32 consist of restricted funds for approved vacancies for Fiscal Year
- 33 2024 that may not be utilized for active Fiscal Year 2023
- 34 Headcount. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that
- 35 the funds provided for vacancies are used to increase headcount
- 36 and not for promotions, title changes, in-range salary adjustments
- 37 or any other mechanism for increasing salaries for current
- 38 employees. It is the Legislature's intention that no employee
- 39 salary falls below the minimum salary established by the
- 40 Mississippi State Personnel Board.
- Additionally, the State Personnel Board shall determine and
- 42 publish the projected annualized payroll costs based on current
- 43 employees. It shall be the responsibility of the agency head to

- 44 ensure that actual personnel expenditures for Fiscal Year 2024 do
- 45 not exceed the data provided by the Legislative Budget Office. If
- 46 the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 projected cost exceeds the
- 47 annualized costs, no salary actions shall be processed by the
- 48 State Personnel Board except for new hires determined to be
- 49 essential for the agency.
- Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 51 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law or
- 52 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 53 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 54 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 55 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 56 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 57 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 58 appropriated level.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 60 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds used for
- 61 salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are
- 62 withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 64 violation of the Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A
- 65 relating to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 66 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 67 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 68 Mississippi Arts Commission shall maintain complete accounting and

69	personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
70	appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
71	same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
72	2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
73	agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to
74	the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
75	detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
76	during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.
77	SECTION 5. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
78	Section 2, funds in the amount of One Million Four Hundred Ninety
79	Thousand Dollars (\$1,490,000.00) shall be derived from the
80	Education Enhancement Fund deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75
81	and 27-67-31, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the following:
82	Training of educators and promotion of arts programs in
83	public schools\$ 100,000.00
84	Miscellaneous grants and programs\$ 350,000.00
85	Whole Schools Initiative 1,040,000.00
86	SECTION 6. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
87	Arts Commission shall have the authority to transfer dollars
88	appropriated herein designated for the "Challenge Program,"
89	specific amounts to a special fund in the State Treasury called
90	the Arts Commission Challenge Initiative Fund. The unexpended
91	amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall
92	not lapse into the State General Fund and may be expended by the
93	commission in subsequent fiscal years upon appropriation of the

- 94 Legislature. Any interest earned on the fund shall be deposited
- 95 to the credit of the fund and may be disbursed by the commission
- 96 upon appropriations of the Legislature. It is the intention of
- 97 the Legislature that the commission may award grants to arts
- 98 organizations from monies in the fund and the grantees will be
- 99 required to provide matching funds for the grants in an amount of
- 100 not less than two (2) times the amount of the grant.
- 101 **SECTION 7.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 102 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 103 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things
- 104 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 105 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 106 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 107 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 108 made without competitive bids.
- 109 **SECTION 8.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 110 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 111 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 112 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 113 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 114 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 115 actions contrary to this provision.
- 116 **SECTION 9.** Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
- 117 Section 2, Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000.00), or so much
- 118 thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury

119	to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section
120	27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a manner as
121	determined by the Treasurer's Office. This appropriation is made
122	for the purpose of providing the funds necessary to authorize the
123	expenditure of funds for the Building Fund for the Arts.
124	SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions
125	of Section 2, One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00), or so much
126	thereof, shall be derived out of any money in the State Treasury
127	to the credit of the Capital Expense Fund, as created in Section
128	27-103-303, Mississippi Code of 1972, and allocated in a manner as
129	determined by the Treasurer's Office. This appropriation is made
130	for the purpose of providing the funds necessary to authorize the
131	expenditure of funds to the Mississippi Museum of Art.
132	SECTION 11. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
133	necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the Capital
134	Expense Fund not otherwise appropriated for the Arts Commission
135	for the purpose of reauthorizing the expenditure of Capital
136	Expense Funds, as authorized in HB 1598, 2022 Regular Session to
137	provide for the funding of the Building Fund for the Arts
138	Initiative for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023, and ending
139	June 30, 2024\$ 1,700,000.00.
140	Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
141	the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
142	section, shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds
143	remaining as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the

144	previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not
145	change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.
146	SECTION 12. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
147	the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
148	credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
149	warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
150	Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
151	proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.
152	SECTION 13. This act shall take effect and be in force from
153	and after July 1, 2023.
