## HOUSE BILL NO. 1630

1 2 3	AN ACT APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE OF SPECIAL FUNDS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE PAT HARRISON WATERWAY DISTRICT FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is authorized and approved for expenditure out of any
7	funds which are received by or otherwise become available to the
8	Pat Harrison Waterway District, for the purpose of defraying the
9	expenses of the district for the fiscal year beginning
10	July 1, 2023, and ending June 30, 2024
11	\$ 7,662,825.00.
12	SECTION 2. Of the funds approved for expenditure under the
13	provisions of Section 1, the following positions are authorized:
14	AUTHORIZED HEADCOUNT:
15	Permanent: 58
16	Time-Limited: 0
17	With the funds herein appropriated, it shall be the agency's
18	responsibility to make certain that funds required for Personal

- 19 Services for Fiscal Year 2025 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2024 funds
- 20 appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are
- 21 added to the agency's Fiscal Year 2024 budget by the Mississippi
- 22 Legislature. The Legislature shall determine the agency's
- 23 personal services appropriation, which shall be published by the
- 24 State Personnel Board. Additionally, the State Personnel Board
- 25 shall determine and publish the projected annualized payroll costs
- 26 based on current employees. It shall be the responsibility of the
- 27 agency head to ensure that actual personnel expenditures for
- 28 Fiscal Year 2024 do not exceed the data provided by the
- 29 Legislative Budget Office. If the agency's Fiscal Year 2024
- 30 projected cost exceeds the annualized costs, no salary actions
- 31 shall be processed by the State Personnel Board with the exception
- 32 of new hires that are determined to be essential for the agency.
- 33 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with
- 34 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law or
- 35 allowable under the terms set forth within this act. The State
- 36 Personnel Board shall not escalate positions without written
- 37 approval from the Department of Finance and Administration. The
- 38 Department of Finance and Administration shall not provide written
- 39 approval to escalate any funds for salaries and/or positions
- 40 without proof of availability of new or additional funds above the
- 41 appropriated level.
- 42 No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 43 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are

- 44 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 45 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- None of the funds herein appropriated shall be used in
- 47 violation of Internal Revenue Service's Publication 15-A relating
- 48 to the reporting of income paid to contract employees, as
- 49 interpreted by the Office of the State Auditor.
- 50 Funds have been appropriated herein for the purpose of
- 51 funding Project SEC2 minimum salaries for all employees covered
- 52 under the Colonel Guy Groff/Neville Kenning Variable Compensation
- 53 Plan. It shall be the agency's responsibility to ensure that the
- 54 funds are used to increase all employees' salaries up to the
- 55 minimum level as determined by the State Personnel Board.
- 56 **SECTION 3.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 57 Pat Harrison Waterway District shall maintain complete accounting
- 58 and personnel records related to the expenditure of all funds
- 59 appropriated under this act and that such records shall be in the
- 60 same format and level of detail as maintained for Fiscal Year
- 61 2023. It is further the intention of the Legislature that the
- 62 agency's budget request for Fiscal Year 2025 shall be submitted to
- 63 the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of
- 64 detail comparable to the format and level of detail provided
- 65 during the Fiscal Year 2024 budget request process.
- 66 **SECTION 4.** It is the intention of the Legislature that
- 67 whenever two (2) or more bids are received by this agency for the
- 68 purchase of commodities or equipment, and whenever all things

- 69 stated in such received bids are equal with respect to price,
- 70 quality and service, the Mississippi Industries for the Blind
- 71 shall be given preference. A similar preference shall be given to
- 72 the Mississippi Industries for the Blind whenever purchases are
- 73 made without competitive bids.
- 74 **SECTION 5.** The funds herein approved for expenditure, except
- 75 and less an amount approved by the State Fiscal Officer which
- 76 shall be sufficient to cover disbursements for current operations,
- 77 shall be deposited at interest with any official depository of the
- 78 state at a rate of interest numerically not less than one percent
- 79 (1%) below the bank discount rate on United States Treasury bills
- 80 of comparable maturity as determined by the State Treasurer.
- 81 **SECTION 6.** It is the intention of the Legislature that the
- 82 funds herein appropriated shall be expended in compliance with
- 83 Section 27-104-25, Mississippi Code of 1972, that no state agency
- 84 shall incur obligations or indebtedness in excess of their
- 85 appropriation and that the responsible officers, either personally
- 86 or upon their official bonds, shall be held responsible for
- 87 actions contrary to this provision.
- 88 **SECTION 7.** The money herein approved for expenditure shall
- 89 be disbursed upon bank checks signed by the proper person, officer
- 90 or officers, in the manner provided by law.
- 91 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 92 and after July 1, 2023, and shall stand repealed June 30, 2023.
