HOUSE BILL NO. 1643
(As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING A REAPPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE
2 AND ADMINISTRATION TO REAUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF CAPITAL
3 EXPENSES AND SPECIAL FUNDS PREVIOUSLY APPROPRIATED FOR
4 CONSTRUCTION AND/OR REPAIR AND RENOVATION PROJECTS AT VARIOUS
5 STATE AGENCIES AND INSTITUTIONS, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

7 **SECTION 1.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the State
9 Treasury to the credit of Fund No. 3393100000 to the Department of
10 Finance and Administration, acting through the Bureau of Building,
11 Grounds and Real Property Management, for the purpose of
12 reauthorizing the expenditure of funds previously appropriated for
13 construction and/or repair and renovation projects at various
14 state agencies and institutions, as authorized in HB No. 1603,
15 2022 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023,
16 and ending June 30, 2024.....\$ 90,392,052.00.

17 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
18 the expenditure of special funds for construction and/or repair



19 and renovation projects at various state agencies and institutions
20 that had been authorized by the Legislature in prior fiscal years.

21 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
22 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
23 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of the funds
24 remaining as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the
25 previous fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not
26 change the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

309 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
310 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
311 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of funds remaining
312 as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the previous
313 fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not change
314 the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

315 **SECTION 17.** The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
316 necessary, is reappropriated out of any money in the State

319 Grounds and Real Property Management, as authorized in Senate Bill
320 3045, 2022 Regular Session, for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
321 2023, and ending June 30, 2024.....\$8,700,000.00.

322 This reappropriation is made for the purpose of reauthorizing
323 the expenditure of Special Funds escalated by the Department of
324 Finance and Administration, Bureau of Building in the prior fiscal
325 year for construction and/or repair, renovation, and improvement
326 of state-owned properties, universities, and community colleges
327 per authorization in Senate Bill 3045, 2022 Regular Session.

328 Notwithstanding the amount reappropriated under this section,
329 the amount that may be expended under the authority of this
330 section shall not exceed the unexpended balance of funds remaining
331 as of June 30, 2023, from the amount authorized for the previous
332 fiscal year. In addition, this reappropriation shall not change
333 the purpose for which the funds were originally authorized.

334 **SECTION 18.** The Bureau of Building, Grounds and Real
335 Property Management of the Office of General Services is expressly
336 authorized and empowered to receive, budget and expend any state,
337 local or other source funds designated for supplemental funding of
338 construction and/or repair and renovation projects.

339 **SECTION 19.** The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
340 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
341 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon



342 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
343 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
344 proper person, officer or officers, in the manner provided by law.

345 **SECTION 20.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
346 and after July 1, 2023.
